COVID-19 News

- Thailand's total death from the onset of the Covid-19 infection has surpassed 10,000 today with today's 297 deaths reported from the virus.



❖ Total New Infections = 18,417

➤ Community Infection = 18,271

➤ Prison Infection = 146

❖ Total positive cases (ATK/Antigen) = 1,185

❖ Total New Death = 297

❖ Total New Recovery = 21,186

❖ Total Infection including ATK = 19,602

❖ Total infections so far since outbreak = 1,102,368

❖ Total deaths so far since outbreak = 10,085

 - ❖ RT-PCR Tests undertaken as per data from govt. = 50,569
 - ❖ Total testing positive under in these tests for the 7-day = 19,455
 - ❖ % Of testing positive = 38.47%




- The Government Pharmaceutical Organization (GPO) came out to say that it has invited Pfizer to come and apply for bringing the vaccine after the US FDA took the Covid-19 vaccine by Pfizer away from 'Emergency Use' to being normal which means that it can be imported by hospitals without having to go through the government.
 - ❖ The GPO said that it would take about 30-days to approve the nearly 30,000-40,000 pages of documents of Pfizer for the Covid-19 vaccine.
- As for the grand opening of the Thai borders within 120-days as announced by 2014 coup leader – Prayut Chan-o-cha, on June 16th in a televised address to the country, the reopening of the borders has less than 50-days remaining for that deadline.



Inoculation Drive

- The inoculation remains at the same pace as it was in the past few days but those getting the 4th dose continues to rise with 4 more people getting the 4th dose yesterday to a total of 239 people and again the country 70%+ population are still awaiting their 1st dose.



- As for the overall inoculation and the target of 100 million doses by the end of the year 2021, well the achievements are in the report card below.
 - ❖ Inoculated - 27.70 million or 27.7% of 100 million target.
 - ❖ To be inoculated - 72.299 million in 129 days that remains in 2021.

- ❖ Inoculation per day needed to achieve the target - 560,459 doses per day.

Economic News

- There are talks to open various businesses to people who are fully vaccinated and/or have Swab test or Antigen Test Kits (ATK) tests that shows that they are negative.
 - ❖ Reasons to loosen the lockdown is due to the decrease in the number of infections and the number of vaccines and vaccinations has increased.

- ❖ Apart from Factory Bubble & Seal Measures have been taken. reduce the economic impact including the need to reduce political pressure.
- The meeting was attended by Anutin Charnvirakul, Deputy Prime Minister and the Minister of Public Health and the 9 associations and discussion was on ways to relaxing of measures to enable business operations. There were total of 9 associations that were present at the meeting yesterday. The plan is to present this by Friday to the Center for Covid-19 Situation Administration (CCSA).
 - ❖ Supanawit Eamsakulrat Director of the Thai Shopping Center Association said that the Shopping Center Association proposed three phases:
 - Phase 1 by September 1, which is to open a food and beverage business with dine-in at 50% capacity and open a business of decoration and furniture, dental clinic, massage parlor, spa that specializes in foot massage, medical clinic, beauty salon business, IT business, service business such as car wash, key repair, post office miscellaneous such as eyeglass shop, golf course and outdoor sports.
 - Phase 2 by September 15, open dine-in restaurant business to 75% of capacity, clothing business, costume and educational institutions.
 - Phase 3, by September 30 or sooner, is a 100% capacity of dine-in restaurant business, spa business, children's playground equipment, fitness business, movie theater business. and banquet rooms.
- The discussion lasted more than three hours, with Dr. Kiatpoom Wongrachit, Permanent Secretary of the Ministry of Public Health, who briefly stated that the Ministry of Public Health accepted the principle and asked the Department of Disease Control to study the details before presenting at the meeting of the Center for Covid-19 Situation Administration (CCSA) on August 27th.
 - ❖ It is reported that the meeting will consider unlocking 4-5 businesses related to travel, restaurants, outdoor activities, malls to be effective from September 1, 2021, but stipulates conditions to control users such as complete 2 injections of vaccinations, SWAP before receiving services or check with ATK kit
- Manpong Senanarong, Deputy Manager, Head of Issuer Division the Stock Exchange of Thailand revealed that the first half of the year 2021 listed companies on the Stock Exchange of Thailand reported better earnings compared to the previous year, while the operating results of the 2nd quarter slowed down slightly.

- ❖ A total of 738 listed companies representing 97.4% from a total of 758 companies delivering results in the 2nd quarter of the year, they found that they had better performance. Total sales were 6.076 trillion baht, an increase of 18.0% compared to the previous year.
 - ❖ While profit from core operations was 804.953 billion baht, an increase of 118.6%, and a net profit of 528.342 billion baht, an increase of 144.2%.
 - Prasit Boonduangprasert Chief Executive Officer Charoen Pokphand Foods Plc (CPF) revealed that now there is a severe labor shortage in the food business.
 - ❖ A discussion with the government via the Ministry of Labor was to set standards for importing foreign workers, who have been vaccinated against COVID-19.
 - These workers should be put in a state or company sponsored quarantine premises for workers before entering the state to work on a state-to-state basis (G to G).
 - Thiraphong Chansiri, Chief Executive Officer of Thai Union Group Plc (TU), said the government should allow foreign workers to enter in accordance with the law, but be strict in their checking before these workers crossed the border. These workers, he said, must first test for COVID and self-isolate for 14 days before testing again, including vaccination to increase the production of Thai products for exports.
 - B. Grimm Power Plc (BGRIM) revealed that in the case of PTT Global LNG Company Limited (PTTGL), a subsidiary of PTT Group Plc (PTT), together with BGRIM established B.Grimm Power LNG JV Company Limited (BGP LNG JV) formed a joint-venture with shareholding of 50:50 with a registered capital of 50 million baht to penetrate the LNG import business to supply power plant customers in industrial estates.
 - ❖ Currently the new business is in the process of negotiating with many customers. Once the figures are finalized, they can be presented to the government within 2021.

Political News

- The constitution amending committee lead by Paiboon Nititawan, the key leader of the ruling Phalang Pracharat party, has decided to withdraw 5 clauses of the planned amendment ahead of the presentation to the parliament for the 2nd and 3rd reading in the near future.

- ❖ The planned withdrawal comes as Move Forward party had opposed many of the clauses prompting a possible need to seek interpretations from the Constitutional Court.
- ❖ The clauses that were withdrawn were
 - Section 85 on the announcement of election results within 30 days.
 - Article 92 on the requirements for winning a 'No Vote' or an electoral vote that does not elect anyone to be a member of the House of Representatives, if any constituency which elects a member of the House of Representatives gets less votes than a 'No Vote' then there is a need to hold new elections and prohibit applicants existing contestants for the MP in that constituency to run for new elections.
 - Section to repeal Section 94 on calculating the electoral vote to find a list of MPs.
 - Section to repeal paragraph 3 of Section 105 concerning the calculation of party-list MP proportions.
 - Transitional provisions sections on the determination of time period for the National Assembly to enact Organic Act (Act) governing the election of members of the House of Representatives within 120 days.
- ❖ The committee decided to maintain section 83 and section 91 as the parliament accepted the principle in the draft the charter amendment proposed by the Democrat Party.
 - This they said was not to be interpreted as anything to do with the announcement by Prayut Government's coalition member Bhumjai Thai Party, which announced its stance of not supporting the charter amendment.
- Later, there was a joint meeting of the parliament to consider the draft constitutional amendment voted and discussed the urgent motion of Teeratchai Phantumas, a member of the list of MP of Move Forward party.
- ❖ Teeratchai had requested the parliament to discuss on the 2 ballot voting is beyond the scope of the parliament to discuss.

- ❖ This led to a voting which saw the proposal by Teeratchai being overturned with 374 votes against the motion by Teeratchai and 60 voting in favor.
- Paradorn Prissanantakul, MP Ang Thong and spokesman for the Bhumjai Thai party said that it would not support the planned amendment including exercising the right to abstain and abstain from voting for the motions.
 - ❖ Voting for the 2nd and 3rd agenda because of this constitutional amendment was being undertaken to resolve and benefit politicians, not the people. Bhumjai Thai Party has the same stance on setting up a Constituent Assembly to allow people to set rules for choosing MPs.
- Ratchada Thanadirek, Deputy Spokesman for the Prime Minister's Office, announced that the Cabinet meeting (Cabinet) discussed the appropriate date for the discussion of no-confidence in the government from August 31st onwards.
 - ❖ As for which day it will be clearer after all 3 parties are consulted and clarified about the suitable dates.
- The cabinet meeting approved Anucha Burapachaisri as the Deputy Secretary-General of the Prime Minister for Political Affairs and Thanakorn Wang Boonkongchana to be a spokesman for the Prime Minister's Office instead.
 - ❖ The Cabinet also approved a proposed by the Ministry of Interior for the resignation of Weerasak Wichit Saengsri who resigned from the position of Governor of Samut Sakhon to become the governor of Angthong province.

 - While arrest warrant is set to be issued today (after the entire social media was buzzing with the news and Joe has reportedly left the country).
