Thai Enquirer Summary

Political News

- Today is the day that both Prayut & Prawit are set to go to different places.
 - ❖ Questions have been raised on the reasons for this trip as Prayut is going to areas that are controlled by Saam Mittr group in Phalang Pracharat party (PPRP).
 - ❖ Prayut has been ‘working from home’ even when the situation was worse during the peak of the outbreak of Covid-19 but now questions are being raised why Prayut is heading to a constituency that is controlled by this faction although the flooding in Phetchaburi province has many questions that cannot be answered. A total of about 12 MPs are set to join this group’s trip including Bhumjai Thai party’s Pipat Ratchakitprakarn, Minister of Tourism and Sports.
 - ❖ Drug dealer convict – Thammanat Prompao will accompany Prawit, while labour Minister Suchart Chomklin will accompany Prayut. A total of 40 MPs are set to join this group’s trip.

- The Emergency Decree is set to be replaced and not extended after September 30th
 - ❖ The government spokesman has come out to say that there is no ‘blanket amnesty’ for this decree.
 - ❖ Yesterday at the Cabinet meeting (Cabinet) approved the draft decree to amend the Communicable Disease Act B.E. and added a section on the management of public health emergencies which in the future will not have to enact the Royal Decree on government administration in emergency situations (Emergency decree).
- Talks in the political circles are that there is a need for political parties to be prepared for elections as the government of Prayut may not be able to last for longer than 6-months.
 - ❖ All eyes are on the fierce vengeance by drug dealing convicted former minister of Prayut administration who was sacked earlier this month by Prayut.
 - ❖ All sources indicate that Thammanat is likely to be very vengeful and could topple the government of Prayut when the time is right.
 - ❖ This has prompted all political parties to start to prepare for elections.
- Questions have been raised on the visit of both Prayut and Prawit and that one should keep an eye on the project to use the budget to manage water resources, especially the members of the coalition government, presenting a water resource management project through the Ministry of Interior Ministry of Agriculture and Cooperatives.
 - ❖ This includes the amendment of the annual budget expenditure 2022, and the Cabinet meeting on September 14, 2021, approved the central budget of 3.85 billion baht to implement the 2021 flood prevention project and alleviate 3,378 drought problems in 2021/2022 which must be completed within 120 days, not later than January 2022
- 12-billion-baht leak
 - ❖ Thailand’s parliament that took years of delay to be constructed and costed the state coffers more than 12-billion baht with the construction contract being awarded to Sino-Thai Construction Plc (STEC), a company owned by the family of current Deputy Prime Minister and Public Health Minister – Anutin Charnvirakul, was once again leaking due to the heavy rain in the past few days.
 - ❖ The leak is nothing new as the building has been marred with all these leaks ever since it opened its doors just over 2-years ago.

- ❖ The leak this time was reported on social media by Watchara Petchthong, former member of the party list MP of Democrat Party.
 - This leak took place on September 18 at the House of Representatives on the first floor of the Senate building,
 - He therefore said that today (September 22), will file a complaint letter to Parliament Speaker Chuan Leekpai and Pornphit Petcharoen, secretary-general of the council for inspection.



Economic News

- The Tourism Authority of Thailand (TAT) has come out to say that the plans for having the 5 big tourist destinations to open by October 1st or October 15th needs to be delayed to at least November 1st.

- ❖ The aim says that Bangkok, Pattaya, Cha Am, Hua Hin, Chiang Mai etc cities would open by November 1st to allow all areas to have 70% of the population have at least 2 doses of vaccination.
- ❖ Yuthasak Supasorn, Governor of the Tourism Authority of Thailand (TAT), said that the progress of Phase 2 plans to opening up of 5 more provinces, namely Bangkok, Chonburi (Pattaya, Bang Lamung District, Sattahip District), Chiang Mai (Mueang District, Mae Taeng District, Mae Rim District, Doi Tao District), Phetchaburi (Cha-am) and Prachuap Khiri Khan (Hua Hin) to receive foreign tourists.
- ❖ The working group from the Ministry of Public Health therefore deems it advisable to postpone the schedule at least 1 month.



- Lots of criticism against the planned raising of the debt to GDP to 70% as people have questioned on the way the funds are being used.
 - ❖ Opposition have questioned on how the country will repay back the higher debts while some parties are already saying
 - ❖ Napaporn Petchinda, a party list MP of Seri Ruam Thai party said that the government's requests to extend the loan ceiling from 60 to 70% is to prepare an additional loan of more than 1 trillion baht in the hopes to buy people's hearts through various projects.
 - She said that with this 1-trillion baht, when General Prayut wins the election, he will rely on the votes of 250 senators to come back as prime minister for 20 years in accordance with the National Strategic Plan.
- Khon Lah Krung, can be used after October 4th for use in deliver applications as well.

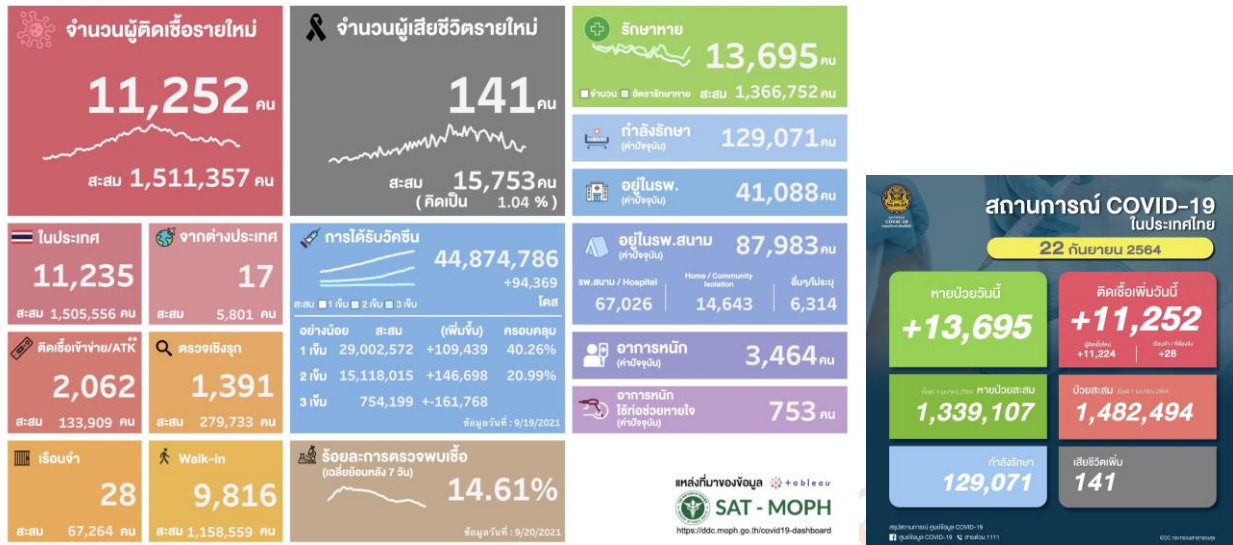
- ❖ The new round of 'Pay Together' is the 3rd phase of this successful project of the Prayut administration.
- ❖ Kulaya Tantitemit, Director of the Fiscal Policy Office, spokesman for the Ministry of Finance, revealed that the Cabinet has agreed to reduce the number of target groups who are entitled to the 'Khon Lah Krung' phase 3 project from 31 million rights to 28 million.
- ❖ As of September 20, 2021, the project is Khon Lah Krung, Phase 3, with 24.22 million cumulative users, total accumulated spending of 66.37 billion baht, and the more you use, the more you get 75,582 accumulated users.
 - The total public spending is 2.18 billion baht and accumulated spending on e-vouchers 90.7 million baht
- ❖ On October 1, 2021, the Ministry of Finance will transfer the amount of support to those who are entitled to the project Khon Lah Krung, Phase 3, round 2, additional 1,500 baht, can be spent until December 31, 2021.
- Advanced Info Services Plc (ADVANC) and Siam Commercial Bank Plc (SCB) came out to announce that they were joining hands to offer loans to ADVANC's more than 46 million customers.
 - ❖ The 50/50 JV is to pursue digital lending and is called AISCB.
 - ❖ The objective of AISCB is to provide the digital lending via online platform to enhance the access to financial service.
 - ❖ ADVANC has 43.2 million subscribers, 10.98 million are post-paid including 1.2 million in 5G, and 32.2 million prepaid.
 - ❖ ADVANC has informatics on these subs base - online shopping, entertainment preferences that - while observing privacy rules - can still be mined for big data analysis for product offering and funding needs.
 - ❖ AISPAY is the payment application of ADVANC that is growing in users thanks to persistent campaign to subs to migrate.
 - ❖ ADVANC has 1.5 million fibre customers and growing. It is currently number 4 but it looks like it can edge out TOT from the number 3 position if it can hit 1.8-2.0 million.

- Apart from this Siam Commercial Bank Plc (SCB) will have a board meeting and there are a few important agenda regarding the major restructuring of SCB's business to become a Holding Company and is scheduled for a press conference at 17:00 hrs by Arthit Nanthawittaya, Chief Executive Officer of SCB.
 - ❖ The source revealed that the main important agenda is
 - The separation of the leasing business (Hire Purchase Loan Group) is a new company (Spin-Off) to be listed on the Stock Exchange of Thailand in early 2022.
 - ✓ Based on the data at the end of June 30, 2021, SCB has a total hire purchase loan value of 229.97 billion baht, divided into loans New cars 132 billion baht, used car loans 55.10 billion baht and car loans 41.40 billion baht.
 - In addition, separate the digital loan business group and entering the cryptocurrency business, such as creating a trading platform or a secondary market in coin issuance (ICO) of both domestic and foreign investors. including separating the credit card business to establish a new company.
- On September 22, in the seminar Awakening the power of exports Turning the Thai economy Jurin Laksanawisit, Deputy Prime Minister and Minister of Commerce will reveal export numbers in August 2021, which has a continuous positive trend.
 - ❖ And there is a chance to expand in double digits for another month, with export figures for the whole year 2021 according to the Ministry of Commerce's plan, it is expected to grow 12-13% for sure, including the direction of driving exports in the last curve. that the private sector stated There is a continuous influx of orders.
- Thanakorn Wangboonkongchana, spokesman for the Prime Minister's Office revealed that the Cabinet meeting approved the central budget for the year 2021 amounting to 27.57 billion baht for the Civil State Welfare Fund for Foundations of Economy and Society for expenses in 4 main groups
 - ❖ Extend the period of measures to relieve the burden of water Electricity bills for those who have a welfare card of the same state for another 12 months from Oct. 2021 - Sep. 2022, with a limit of 2.02 billion baht, helping to pay electricity bills for 1.9 million households. and water bills for 186,625 households.

- ❖ Provide welfare for 13.56 million people with state welfare cards, with an amount of 18.82 billion baht for household expenses cooking gas cost travel expenses and disability allowance.
 - Those who earn more than 30,000 baht but not more than 100,000 baht/year receive 200 baht/person/month,
 - Those who earn less than 30,000 baht/year receive 300 baht/person/month and receive a discount.
 - Cooking gas 55 baht/person/3 months, fare for BMTA, BTS SkyTrain, Railway Station, 500 baht/person/month.
- ❖ 3. Implemented a new round of state welfare card registration project with a limit of 1.64 billion baht to be accurate in identifying low-income earners who were the missing groups in the previous round.
- ❖ Welfare allocation for those who hold a new state welfare card, amounting to 4.53 billion baht.
- Amornthep Chawala, Executive Vice President, Research Office, CIMB Thai Bank, revealed that if the government wants to borrow more money, it must also borrow to restructure the economy.
 - ❖ He said that if the government wants the economy to grow above the potential of 3% because household income is now slowly growing, affecting Thai household debt in the next 5 years may exceed 100% per GDP from the first quarter of 64 at 90.5% per GDP because the economy is not expanding. But people still need more loans to spend, buy cars and buy houses.
 - ❖ The benefit of borrowing money the government sector must work with the Bank of Thailand (BoT), possibly allowing the BoT to inject money into the system or create a QE by buying bonds and the Monetary Policy Committee (MPC) meeting to be held on September 29th may cut the policy interest rate. to abandon economic stimulus measures before the global financial market reverts to an uptrend in interest rates.

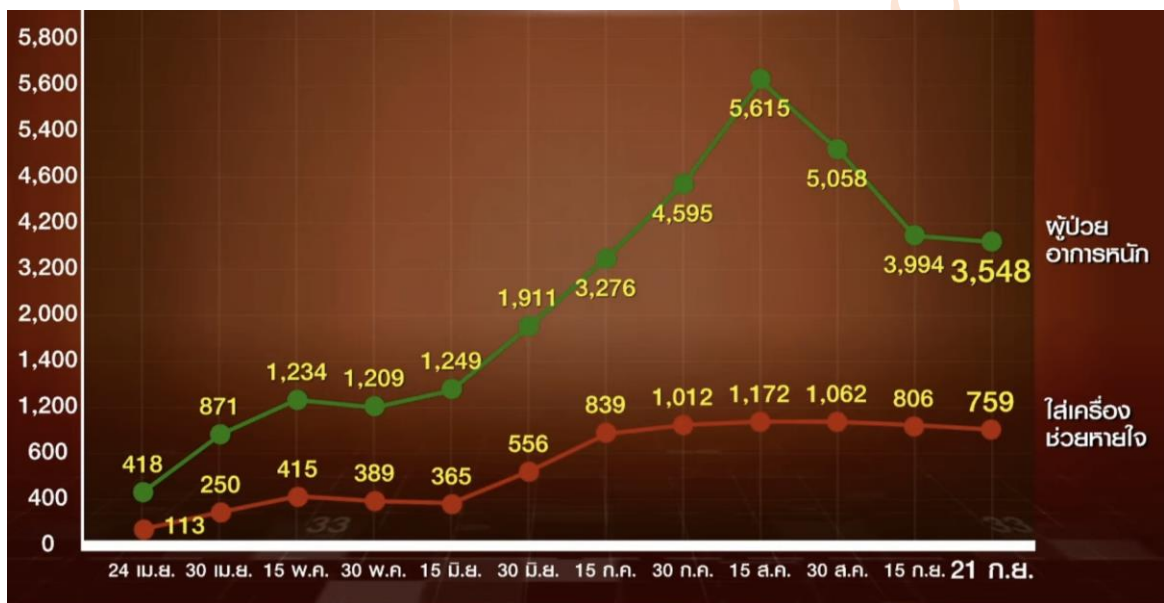

- There is some good news as the number of infected people in ICU and on life support has been declining and hospital beds are starting to become available.



- ❖ The data above shows data from April 24th when only 418 people were in ICU and 113 on Ventilators

- It rose to a peak on August 15th with 5,615 in ICU and 1,172 on life support

- As of September 21st it is 3,548 people in ICU and 759 on ventilators.

- As for inoculation data



- ❖ Total inoculation for 2 doses so far has been at 16.18 million people out of the nearly 70 million people in the country.
 - But the target is for 50 million people to be vaccinated with 2 doses by end of the year, therefore 32.36% of the 50 million people are now fully vaccinated.
- ❖ Total inoculation needed to reach the 50 million people target by the end of 2021 means that another 33.82 million people need to be vaccinated.
