Thai Enquirer Summary

Economic News

- The plans to bring in 2 world class celebrities to come and perform during the countdown has been confirmed and the state would fork out 100 million baht for the event that would take place at Sarasin bridge in Phuket.
 - ❖ Phiphat Ratchakitprakarn, Minister of Tourism and Sports revealed that teenage heartthrob from Blackpink Lalisa Manoban (LISA) and Italian opera singer – Andrea Bocelli, have both confirmed their attendance for the countdown.
 - ❖ The contract for these 2 to perform at the same venue is set to be signed within this week and the government would spend 100 million baht while the remainder may come from private sector who would be the sponsor for the event.

- Meanwhile Yuthasak Supasorn, Governor of the Tourism Authority of Thailand (TAT), said that the opening of the country from November 1 is expected to increase the number of foreign tourists entering Thailand in 2021 with an expectation that by the end of year Thailand may see up to 1 million people entering the kingdom.

- ❖ The aim is for the country to gradually recover in 2022 and tourism revenue could reach as high as 1.5 trillion baht or about 50% of the revenue the country had seen in 2019.
- ❖ Tourism revenue is expected to recover to 2.4 trillion baht in 2023 or 80% of those seen in 2019 and in 2024 Thailand's tourism revenue is expected to return to the level seen in 2019.
- ❖ Thailand has allowed double vaccinated tourists from 45 low-risk countries and 1 Special Administrative Region (Hong Kong) that can travel in Thailand without quarantine.
- ❖ The list of countries will be reviewed every two weeks to add more countries where the risk of the coronavirus outbreak has been reduced.

- Citibank (Thailand), the key asset of Citibank N.A. in Asia has seen as many as 4 bidders submit their bids as of Friday (October 22) which was the deadline for the bid submission.

- CNN news agency reveals the results of a months-long investigation that found fake and second-hand medical grade nitrile gloves from Thailand that was imported to the United States, where 10's of millions of pieces which the US and Thai authorities are investigating as a crime by bringing up a raid on a warehouse on the outskirts of Bangkok.
 - ❖ A large number of used medical gloves were found in garbage bags and some pieces have blood stains. They were being repacked in well branded boxes and sent out of the country.
 - ❖ CNN said several such warehouses in Thailand are still in operation today. Exported to the US and many countries around the world.
- Paradorn Tiornpramote Assistant Director, Research Division, Asia Plus Securities revealed that during the 2 months from mid-August to the present, foreign investors began to gradually return to invest in the Thai stock market with 48 billion baht, almost 50 billion baht, resulting in The Thai stock index to rise by 7%, compared with the international stock market, the Dow Jones, barely rising.
 - ❖ Most of them are buying shares in the banking group, the energy group, the shares that benefit from the weak baht and the open stocks, such as AOT, TIDLOR, KBANK, VGL, BBL, CPALL, MINT, CPN, CBG.
 - ❖ Every time there is a relaxation measure or economic stimulus measures foreigners will return to invest in the Thai stock market, he said.
- Today, October 25, the company is Glory Forever. Plc (GLORY), a famous online literature distribution business via web site and application 'Kawebook', will be listed on the Market for Alternative Investment (Mai).
 - ❖ The debut on the MAI is set to take place after GLORY undertook an initial public offering (IPO) at 2.80 baht a share.
- A source from the State Railway of Thailand (SRT) revealed that the SRT is considering amending the joint venture contracts with private contracting parties on issues related to

Political News

- Political parties are already announcing their candidates for the various constituencies around the country.
 - ❖ Democrat party, a key member of the ruling coalition, has come out to announce some candidates in Isarn area (Northeast of Thailand).
 - ❖ Jurin Laksanawisit, the leader of Democrat party and Deputy Prime Minister & Minister of Commerce, has come out to announce the names of former football player and a businessman to be contesting the elections in the area that has seen the previous poll being won by the Pheu Thai party.
 - Jurin was at Sikhio District in Nakhon Ratchasima province and launched the campaign to push for the new candidates who would be contesting the polls under the Democrat party's banner.
 - ❖ Thai Saang Thai party, which was set up by Sudarat Keyuraphan, also announced its candidates for a few constituencies in Bangkok, where it is considered to be her stronghold.
- The ruling coalition - Palang Pracharat Party (PPRC) has also undertaken a polling of its popularity to gauge its popularity and only 4 out of the 14 MPs in the south passed the polling survey, rest all failed.
 - ❖ PPRP's Secretary General Capt. Thammanat Phromphao, a Phayao MP, said that in the south of Thailand the MPs of PPRP got low passing grades.
 - ❖ Phai Lik, a PPRP MP for Kamphaeng Phet and also a deputy secretary-general of the party said he and Capt. Thammanat had already spoken and that they have had discussion with party leader – Gen. Prawit Wongsuwan, Deputy Prime Minister, on this issue.
 - They agreed that the reason for the polling was to improve the working of the party and that all parties do this all the time to gauge their standing in the various areas.
 - ❖ As part of the move to improve the party's standing General Prawit was proposed to visit the southern region in November at Thepha district, Songkhla province, and a few other places.

- Move Forward party has also headed to the South of Thailand where the party's leader Pita Limjaroenrat, went to Nakorn Si Thammarat to listen to the problems of the people and the continued drop in the prices of fruits, a key agricultural produce of the region.
 - ❖ As for Chumphon province, members of Move Forward party lead by Rangsiman Rome, the MPs and deputy secretary-general of the party visited the area to listen to the problems of the group of food delivery workers (riders) in Chumphon province, amounting to almost 500 people.
 - ❖ After that they travelled to listen to the problems of the people of Phuket, especially entertainment business problems that have been affected by the outbreak of Covid-19.
- Ruangkrai Leekitwattana, a member of the Pracharat Party, who was a member of the Pheu Thai party not too long ago, came out to say that he was preparing to submit a complaint to the Election Commission (EC) to consider submitting a petition to the Constitutional Court to consider dissolving the Pheu Thai Party in case of violation of Section 28 of the Political Party Act.
 - ❖ The Section 28 states that a party should not allow outsiders to intervene and dominate.
 - ❖ Ruangkrai said that from a video call of former Prime Minister Thaksin Shinawatra to the party members, it can be classified as a political party activity because the handwriting of Thaksin writing the word "Phuea Thai Party" or "Tomorrow Pheu Thai" is also used in the party's Facebook page and party members' Facebook pages.
 - ❖ Ruangkrai said that all this could be used against Pheu Thai party to dissolve the party.
- Pheu Thai party's key law expert – Chusak Sirinil, has come out to say that Thaksin's statement to a bunch of MPs cannot construe to be interference because none of the party's executive committee members were there at the event and Thaksin did not direct those present to do anything in particular.
- After being quiet for a few weeks, the protest movement seems to be back on track as the Ratsadorn group has announced that they will return to Ratcharprasong junction to stage a protest.
 - ❖ The Ratdasorn Group has announced that they will hold their protest on October 31st at 16:00 hrs until 21:00 hrs.

- ❖ The key demand would be repeal the lese majeste or article 112.



- The decision by the Chulalongkorn University's student organisation to end the traditional Phra Kieo (coronet) parade which is part of the annual football event between Chulalongkorn University (CU) and Thammasat University has drawn the ire of many CU alumni.
 - ❖ The Student Government of Chulalongkorn University (SGCU) announced on its Facebook account on Saturday, which was also King Chulalongkorn Memorial Day, that its executive committee decided to scrap the long tradition of the parade. According to the remarks, the Phra Kieo procession reflects authoritarianism and fosters a belief that people are not equal.
 - ❖ The activity is also a representation of feudal culture placing one group over another, the SGCU said. It also questioned the transparency of a process to select students to accompany the Phra Kieo which is placed on a palanquin carried along by some 50 students during the procession.
 - ❖ Phra Kieo is a coronet worn by Thai princes and princesses in former times. It became the emblem of Chulalongkorn University when King Rama VI named the university after his father and the university's founder, King Chulalongkorn, Rama V. The Phra Kieo was chosen by King Rama V as his personal emblem and King Rama VI allowed it to be used as the emblem for the Civil Service College, which later became Chulalongkorn University.

 - ❖ The data indicates that the 4 southern provinces had 1,945 cases and 4 deaths, as compared to 1,511 cases and 14 deaths in Bangkok and its neighbouring provinces.
