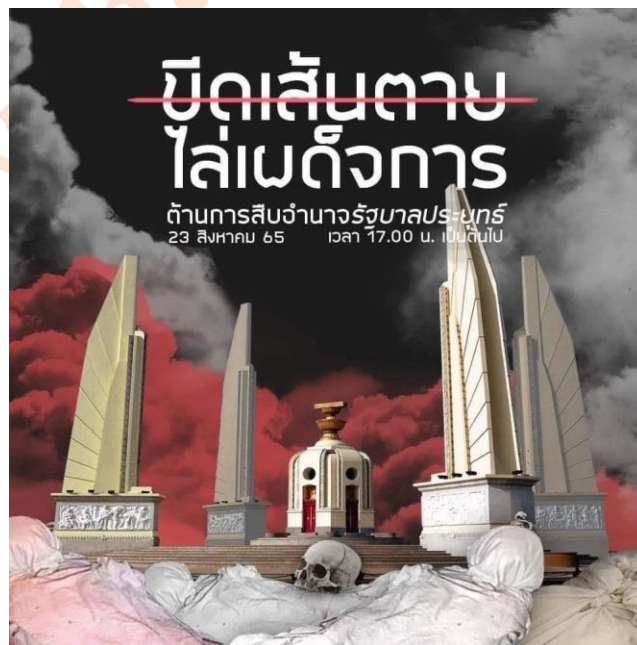
## Thai Enquirer News Summary

### **Political News**

- Many anti-govt groups came back to life to call for Prayut's resignation as the house speaker Chuan Leekpai will today refer a complaint to the Constitutional Court to investigate 2014 coup leader and current Prime Minister Prayut Chan-o-cha's contentious 8-year premiership term limit.
  - ❖ Yesterday, the Ratsadon group marched to Sanam Luang and held a short rally, but they abruptly had to move to a new location at the Democracy Monument because the gate to Sanam Luang were locked.
  - ❖ Panusaya Sithijirawattanakul, the leader of the United Front of Thammasat and Demonstration, demanded that Prayut resign immediately and that the Constitutional Court must announce a ruling on Prayut's premiership on August 24 or order him to stop working pending the investigation.
  - ❖ She added that Prayut and his cabinet would become illegitimate immediately after August 24 and that the parliament should dilute the senate's power to choose the prime minister before the new election began.



- Meanwhile a protest led by Jatuporn Promphan, the leader of the National United Front of Democracy Against Dictatorship, and Nitithorn Lamleua was held for the first day in front of the Bangkok City Hall yesterday to demand the prime minister's resignation.
  - ❖ Jatuporn urged the citizens to cram up every street on August 23 and 24 to pressure what he said was an incompetent prime minister to step down and save the country from facing the impasses he is causing.
  - ❖ Nitithorn claimed that if the Constitutional Court was colluding with Prayut, Thailand would fall into another countrywide havoc, and Prayut would get to learn the citizens' power.



- Seksakon Atthawong, an assistant minister to the prime minister, responded to Jatuporn Promphan and Nitithorn Lamluea who said they would stage a demonstration from August 21-24 to protest against PM Prayut Chan-o-cha's 8-year premiership term, saying everyone abided by the same set of laws and should await the Constitutional Court's ruling first.
  - ❖ Seksakon carried on that a street demonstration was against the law and those who had been released on bail under the court's conditions were at risk of getting back in jail. Street demonstrations had never been a solution to political conflicts evidenced by many protest leaders who were charged with terrorism.
  - ❖ He also urged Prayut's supporters to stay put and wait for the court's ruling, as the prime minister wanted to obey the law and did not want to see the crowd clash like in the past.
- Cholnan Srikaew, a leader of the opposition, stated that the Constitutional Court normally meets every Wednesday, which is on August 24 this week, so if the court sets up a quorum, we might get to see whether the court will order Prayut to stop working as requested or not.
  - ❖ He added that if Prayut is allowed to remain in power, the court will take about a month to craft a ruling, and Prayut's premiership will end on August 24 and a new conflict will erupt.
  - ❖ According to Cholnan, there are three possible scenarios including,
    - Prayut will resign of his own accord.
    - The court will order him to step down.
    - He will be forced to resign by the protestors.
  - ❖ Cholnan added that if he were in Prayut's shoes, he would opt for the first scenario. As for the Pheu Thai's prime minister candidates, he said that the party only had Chaikasem Nitisiri on the list and that his party would not nominate Paetongtarn Shinawatra as an outsider prime minister because she was not ready.

## **Economic News**

- The parliamentary meeting to deliberate the Fiscal Year 2023 budget was in a limbo after the parliament once again failed to reach the required quorum.
  - ❖ The next deliberation is right on August 23<sup>rd</sup>, the day when Gen. Prayut's 8-year term ends @ midnight of August 23<sup>rd</sup> into August 24<sup>th</sup>.
  - ❖ Earlier this month the lack of quorum in the parliament was the root cause of the failure of the passage of the amendment to the 2017 constitution that was to divide the 100 party list MPs by 500 from the original plan of dividing by 100.
  - ❖ The failure to pass the division by 500 by August 15<sup>th</sup> deadline means that the division would be by 100.
- Today the Energy Policy Administration Committee chaired by Energy Minister Supattanapong Punmeechaow will consider supportive measures to alleviate the effects of the fuel tariff (FT) hike, which had been raised to 93.43 satangs per unit for September-December 2022, causing the electricity bill to reach 4.72 Baht per unit.
  - ❖ The committee would then direct the proposals to the cabinet on August 23 for further consideration.
  - ❖ The initial measure, which aims to help 22 million people who use electricity from 1-500 units, will cost about 7-8 billion Baht, divided into two approaches.
    - The household that used electricity less than 300 units would receive the subsidy equal to the last time.

- People who used 301-500 units of electricity would be aided by 24.77 satangs per FT unit.

- Jareeporn Jarukornsakul, Chairman of the Board of Directors of WHA Corp Plc (WHA), revealed that WHA had just agreed to sell 600-700 rai of land to a large Chinese EV manufacturer BYD Auto Industry.
  - ❖ The contract would be signed soon along with the official press conference, which would occur on September 8.
  - ❖ This agreement has caused the backlog of land to rocket to 1,000 rai. Meanwhile, many EV manufacturers are eyeing buying 2,000-3,000 rai of land to build their factories.
  - ❖ Sources said that BYD Auto Industry that is buying lands from WHA is one of the world’s largest EV manufacturers. Operating under the name “BYD Thailand,” the company will build its EV factory in Thailand with a production capacity of 100,000 cars per year and an investment value of 20 billion Baht
