Thai Enquirer News Summary

Political News

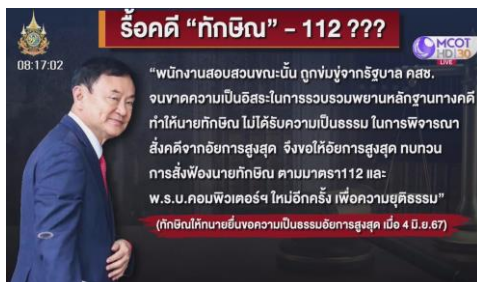
- Chaithawat Tulathon, leader of the Move Forward Party, said that he expects the Constitutional Court to give the party a full opportunity to fight its case against dissolution at the hearing today. He said that the party will submit a large number of witnesses and has multiple arguments in its defense.
 - ❖ Chaithawat also addressed rumors of MP-buying within the party, acknowledging that they are true and that he has been aware of them for several months. However, he said that the most important matter right now is that the party must win the case against its dissolution.
 - ❖ According to political pundits, there are 3 possible outcomes to today's hearing:

- The Court finds that the evidence is sufficient and will set a date for a verdict.
- The Court finds that the evidence is not yet sufficient and may ask the relevant agencies to submit more documents for further investigation.
- The Court finds that the evidence is not yet sufficient and may set a date for further examination.



- Another case, that is weighing on Thailand’s economy, the lese majeste case against former Prime Minister Thaksin Shinawatra, has seen more developments as former Attorney-General Trakul Winitchaipark said he was not ordered or forced to investigate former Prime Minister Thaksin for lese-majeste by the previous junta, the National Council for Peace and Order (NCPO).

- ❖ His comments came after Thaksin's lawyer lodged a petition with the current Attorney-General, Amnat Chetcharoenrak, requesting a review of the decision to indict Thaksin for lese-majeste. In the petition, Thaksin claimed that the investigation committee, chaired by former Attorney-General Trakul, was not independent and had been coerced by the junta to frame him.
- ❖ Former Attorney-General Trakul was appointed by the NCPO after former Attorney-General Atthapol Yaisawang was transferred to an inactive position by an order from the NCPO following the coup.

- The Supreme Court of Appeal upheld 9-month jail sentences for 3 former Bhumjaithai Party MPs who allowed other lawmakers to use their voting cards during a debate on a fiscal budget bill in 2020.
 - ❖ The three include former Phatthalung MP Chalong Thoetweeraphong, former Phatthalung MP Phumsit Khongmee, and former party list MP Natee Ratchakitprakarn. Their political rights were also revoked.
 - ❖ In May last year, the Supreme Court ruled that the three former lawmakers deliberately breached ethics by allowing other MPs to use their electronic voting cards to vote on their behalf during deliberation of the budget bill in the second and third readings between Jan 10-11, 2020.



- The cabinet has approved in principle a law stipulating that anyone found in possession of more than 1 methamphetamine tablet will be regarded as an offender and will not have the option of being sent to rehabilitation.
 - ❖ The draft regulation proposed by the Ministry of Public Health is a response to widespread criticism of an earlier rule specifying that anyone caught with five or more speed pills would be subject to legal action.
 - ❖ The regulation drew flak for opening up a loophole under which anyone possessing between one and four pills would be regarded as a drug addict requiring treatment, meaning they would be able to evade a potential prison sentence.
 - ❖ The draft regulation will now be sent to the Council of State, the government's legal arm, for vetting.
 - ❖ Public Health Minister Somsak Thepsutin said before the cabinet meeting that there is a condition attached to the one-tablet rehab rule: the person must prove they acquired the drug for their own consumption and not for If they fail to prove that, they will face prosecution.

- Police yesterday arrested Noraset Thaised, nephew of Deputy Interior Minister Chada Thaised, and 3 friends at a hotel in Soi Phetchaburi 47 in Bangkok. The suspects were found in possession of 6 bags of methamphetamine, an 11mm pistol, and 6 bullets.
 - ❖ The suspects were taken to Makkasan Police Station for further investigation. They initially denied all charges. Their relatives are preparing bail money of 40,000 Baht each for their release on bail. Police will take the four suspects to the Criminal Court for detention at 10:00 AM today.
 - ❖ Deputy Interior Minister Chada Thaised, who is currently in Saudi Arabia for the Hajj pilgrimage, gave a telephone interview with Thai media. He acknowledged that Noraset is his nephew and said that he has been causing trouble for a long time.
 - ❖ He said that the arrest is justified and that he has nothing to do with the incident. He added that he has never allowed Noraset to enter his house because he is a troublemaker and has a history of drug use. He said that he had warned Noraset before about his behavior.



Economic News

- Deputy Finance Minister Paopoom Rojanasakul called for the Bank of Thailand's Monetary Policy Committee (MPC) to lower the benchmark lending rate by 0.25%.
 - ❖ Paopoom said that the Stock Exchange of Thailand is hitting a 4-year low showed that the economy is still fragile. This is why the government is trying to introduce the 10,000 Baht digital wallet policy as quickly as possible, and related agencies are currently discussing short-term measures to support the stock market as well.
 - ❖ On the monetary policy front, Paopoom said he hoped the central bank would relax its policy interest rate and reduce it by 0.25% to help support the economy. He

pointed out that the European Central Bank has already cut its rate and that the BOT should consider doing the same.

- ❖ The MPC is set to hold its 3rd meeting for the year 2024 today.



- Sanan Angubolkul, President of the Thai Chamber of Commerce, believed that the Bank of Thailand will likely keep its benchmark interest rate unchanged in order to maintain the gap between Thai and US interest rates and support the Thai Baht. The Baht is currently trading at an appropriate level, which is good for Thailand's trade, exports, and tourism, Sanan said.

- ❖ Sanan went on to say that the global interest rate situation is still uncertain and that US inflation remains high at 3%.
- ❖ In Thailand, inflation is starting to show signs of picking up, although core inflation remains low, indicating that the economy is slowing. However, inflation is still within the 1-3% target range. Sanan believed that if the government could clear the doubts surrounding the details of the digital wallet project and other economic stimulus measures, there is a good chance that the Thai economy will rebound.



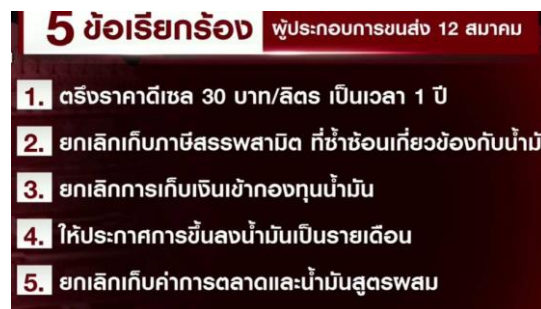
- ❖ Therdsak Thaveeteeratham, Deputy Managing Director of Research at Asia Plus Securities (ASPS), revealed that Thailand's May 2024 inflation data came in higher than expected at 1.54% YoY. This has driven down the real interest rate to 0.96%, lower than both the United States and Europe.

- ❖ Given this situation, Therdsak expected the Bank of Thailand (BoT) to be less likely to cut interest rates in June 2024 and is more likely to maintain the policy rate at 2.5% until the end of the year.
- The Ministry of Commerce's monthly household expenditure survey showed that Thai household expenses have been rising steadily since 2024. The average household expenditure was 17,989 Baht in January, 18,028 Baht in February, and 18,187 Baht in April.
 - ❖ The main factors driving the increase are high fuel prices due to global market conditions and high prices for fresh food, even though prices have not moved recently but remain significantly high.
 - ❖ Somchai Pornrattanacharoen, president of the Wholesale and Retail Trade Association, said that Thais' purchasing power is still slowing down because people are not confident in the economy, do not have additional income, but have additional expenses from the higher cost of living.
 - ❖ Meanwhile, product prices are gradually increasing. Most recently, a manufacturer of a brand of MSG has announced that it will raise its selling price by another 5% or 3-5 Baht per bag in July. The price increase varies by size, for example, the 1 kg size will increase by 5 Baht, while the small size will not increase in price but will reduce the quantity.



- ❖ Today, Bangchak and PTT Station announced another 0.40 Baht increase in the retail prices of benzine and gasohol of all types, while the price of diesel remains unchanged.

- Yesterday The Network of Civil Society Affected by High Oil Prices has called on the government to impose a 30-Baht cap on diesel prices for one year. They said the government should refrain from raising oil prices while the economy is still struggling to recover from the COVID-19 pandemic and the previous global inflation shock.
 - ❖ The current cap is set at 33 Baht per liter, and the group is concerned that it will increase to 35 Baht per liter. They argued that lifting the cap further would lead to even higher production and logistic costs, eventually causing more inflation.
 - ❖ Other demands include abolishing the redundant excise tax related to oil, stopping the collection for the Oil Fuel Fund, and changing the announcements of oil price changes to a monthly basis. This is the fourth letter they have submitted to the government. If there is still no response to their demands after 10 days, they will escalate their movement.



- The Cabinet has approved a proposal from the Mass Rapid Transit Authority of Thailand (MRT) to raise fares on the Blue Line train in line with the Consumer Price Index (CPI). The new fares will be 17-45 Baht, up from the current 17-43 Baht. The increase will take effect on July 3, 2024.
 - ❖ The increase is in accordance with the concession agreement, which allows for fare adjustments every two years. The next adjustment is due on July 2, 2024.
- The Cabinet approved the Finance Ministry's draft directive allowing buyers of the upcoming 3-digit lottery to have a second go if they fail to win in the first draw.
 - ❖ Deputy Finance Minister Paophum Rojanasakul said the draft directive approved on Tuesday will be in addition to an earlier one that allows the Government Lottery Office (GLO) to sell three-digit lotteries. The new draft will allow buyers to specify two sets of three numbers that they want to bet on. The second set of numbers can be the same as the first one. If the first set fails to win, the punters will automatically be eligible for the second draw, he said.
 - ❖ He said GLO has yet to set a date for the launch of the three-digit lottery, even though everything is in place for the kick-off.

- ❖ A Finance Ministry source said this additional directive will make the new three-digit lottery far more attractive than the underground lotto because it will give them two chances for the price of one.

- The Stock Exchange of Thailand (SET) index closed down 2.47 points (-0.19%) yesterday at 1,316.10 points, with a trading value of 45.320 billion Baht. Foreign investors sold a net of 3.2 billion Baht worth of Thai stocks, as the market remained devoid of new factors.
 - ❖ Investors are closely watching domestic political developments, as there is growing uncertainty surrounding the future of the main opposition Move Forward Party, which is facing a dissolution case in the Constitutional Court. The court will meet today to examine the case. On the other hand, the upcoming Monetary Policy Committee (MPC) meeting is not expected to have a significant impact on the market, as it is widely believed that the MPC will keep the interest rate unchanged.
 - ❖ According to analysts, the market is expected to continue to trade sideways today as investors await further clarity on various factors. Support is seen at 1,310 points and resistance at 1,330 points.

- Shares in power generation companies rose yesterday in response to Thailand's power development plan for 2024-2037, which aims to increase the country's renewable energy capacity to 51%. Leading the gains were GULF, which rose 1.25% to close at 40.50 Baht with a trading value of 609 million Baht, GPSC, which rose 0.58% to close at 43.50 Baht

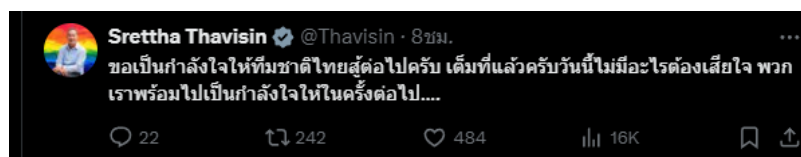
with a trading value of 324 million Baht, and GUNKUL, which rose 2.42% to close at 2.54 Baht with a trading value of 77 million Baht.

- ❖ Today, the Energy Policy and Planning Office (EPPO) will hold a public hearing on the power development plan for 2024-2037 before submitting it to the Cabinet for approval by September.
- The Supreme Administrative Court is today set to rule on a dispute over the construction of the Orange Line metro project. The case was brought by Bangkok Mass Transit System Plc (BTSC), which claims that the second round of bidding for the project was unfair and discriminatory.



General News

- Thailand's national football team defeated Singapore 3-1 in their final Group C match of the 2026 Fifa World Cup qualifiers on Tuesday evening at Rajamangala National Stadium. However, the win was not enough for Thailand to qualify for the next round as Thailand needed to win by three goals to leapfrog China on goal difference.
 - ❖ After the match, Prime Minister Srettha took to X to express his support for the Thai national team, encouraging them to keep fighting and stating that they already gave it their all.





- NBT, the government owned and operated national media house, has reportedly been taken over by the former crew of now defunct – Voice TV (owned by the Shinawatra family).
 - ❖ Teerat Ratanasevi, the former spokesman for the Yingluck Shinawatra government, Virot Ali, Lakkana Punwichai and Weeranan Kanhar have all moved to NBT to set up their base there.
 - ❖ Social media is already buzzing with data that both Teerat and Lakkana have set up a media company with registered capital of 1 million Baht.

- More than 1,000 pets and ornamental fish were reportedly killed after fire broke out in Chatuchak Market in Bangkok in the early hours of Tuesday (June 11). The fire ignited at 4.30am, burning all 118 stores in Sri Somrat Market, which is considered Chatuchak Market's pet zone.
 - ❖ Animals affected by the fire included dogs, cats, rabbits, snakes, birds, Siamese fighting fish, and chickens. No people were injured during the incident.
 - ❖ Meanwhile, Bangkok governor Chadchart Sittipunt has instructed officials to assist victims of the incident. He also invited people to purchase pets at the market to help retailers there.
