Thai Enquirer News Summary

Political News

- The Move Forward Party (MFP)'s dissolution case and the alleged ethical misconduct case against Prime Minister Srettha Thavisin are expected to be concluded before September, said Nakarin Mektrairat, president of the Constitutional Court.





- ❖ Nakarin also said it has yet to be decided whether an inquiry will be opened. However, he noted that in the MFP case, it is just a matter of requesting documents and evidence from the parties involved. The court's next meeting is on Wednesday (July 3), and the previous meeting saw the court asking for more evidence and witnesses in both cases.
- ❖ When asked about the MFP's previous 2 press conferences regarding their defense statement to the court, despite the court's request for the related parties to refrain from making comments that could interfere with the proceedings or sway public opinion, Nakarin said it has yet to be decided whether the press conferences constitute contempt of court. However, he personally does not see anything wrong with it.
- The Election Commission is scrutinizing the qualifications of the 200 new senators in response to complaints filed by senate candidates who did not make it.
 - ❖ Initially, the EC is scheduled to announce the official senate election results on July 3. However, delays are expected due to issues regarding candidate qualifications.



- Yesterday a group of former senatorial candidates, led by Chakkraphong Kongpanya, has petitioned the Election Commission to halt the approval and official announcement of the senate election results. They expressed concerns over reports indicating that many incoming senators lack experience and are relatively unknown in their fields.
 - ❖ They called for further investigation into allegations of manipulation and collusion in the voting process before the EC finalizes the election results. They emphasized that if widespread collusion is found, the results should be annulled, and a new

election should be conducted. Additionally, they insisted that in the event of a new election, the EC must ensure that candidates possess genuine, extensive experience and expertise in their respective fields.

- ❖ Additionally, Jaturun Boonbenjarat, secretary-general of the Clean Politics group and a former candidate, filed a negligence complaint against the EC with the Administrative Court.
- ❖ He accused the EC of failing to meticulously verify candidates' qualifications and requested the court to suspend the announcement of election results until all 200 incoming senators and 100 backup senators' qualifications are re-examined.



- Ketkamon Pliangsamai, the leading candidate in Thailand's recent Senate election, is facing questions regarding the legitimacy of her educational qualifications. Pliangsamai, a medical doctor and professor, claims to hold a doctorate in Political Science from California University, USA.
 - ❖ However, social media posts by CSI LA raise doubts about the university's accreditation. The Facebook page alleged that California University is a diploma mill, as it sells degrees to those seeking high profiles such as foreign degrees. The page also posted images suspected to be the university's premises, which is only a row house building in the USA.



- ❖ Further investigation by Isra News, a Thai investigative news agency, also found that California University has 3 locations in the United States, including the Office of Technology Alliances, Berkeley Mail Center 2000, and 2701 Beverly Blvd, a two-story building, which is believed to be the same location mentioned by CSI LA.
- Pareena Kraikupt, a former MP from Ratchaburi for the Palang Pracharath Party, and Nusara Boonsawad are facing criminal prosecution ordered by the Election Commission.
 - ❖ They are accused of violating the Organic Act on the Election of MPs 2018. Evidence suggested that before the general election on May 11, 2023, Pareena and Nusara allegedly distributed 1,000 Baht to several voters in Ratchaburi province to persuade them to vote for Sihadet Kraikupt, a Bhumjai Thai Party candidate and Pareena's older brother.



- The incoming president of the Pathum Thani Provincial Administrative Organisation (PAO), Chan Puangpetch, is facing an obstacle in assuming office due to an ongoing corruption case against him.
 - ❖ In 2012, the National Anti-Corruption Commission found sufficient evidence implicating Chan in irregularities linked to the procurement of survival kits during his tenure as PAO president. The case has been accepted by the Criminal Court for Corruption and Misconduct Case Region 1 and is currently pending court deliberation. Chan was granted bail for this case in January.
 - ❖ Most recently, the Director-General of the Department of Local Administration sent a letter to the Ministry of Interior explaining that:
 - Chan is eligible to run for election because the case against him is not yet final and he has not been imprisoned or had his candidacy rights revoked.
 - Still, Chan must suspend his duties because the Criminal Court has already accepted the prosecution against him.



- Chan Puangpetch’s victory in the election for president of the Pathum Thani Provincial Administrative Organisation (PAO) showed that voters still have confidence in the Pheu Thai Party, said Digital Economy and Society (DES) Minister Prasert Chantararungthong, a core member of the party.
 - ❖ He also said the result showed that Thaksin Shinawatra’s popularity has not declined. However, the party still has much to prepare ahead of the nationwide PAO election at the beginning of next year, as Chan’s victory was close, with less than a 1,000-vote difference, he added.
- Anutin Charnvirakul, Deputy Prime Minister and leader of the Bhumjai Thai Party, said that regarding Phaisan Phuchmongkol, former Assistant Minister to the Prime Minister’s Office, who said Anutin will become the new prime minister if Srettha Thavisin is ordered by the court to step down from his post, Anutin said that he was unaware of this rumor.
- The Election Commission Office released the summary of political party donations for April 2024. It showed that 169 donors donated a total of 6.77 million Baht to 13 political parties. The party receiving the highest donations was the Bhumjaithai Party, with 95 donors donating a total of 2.43 million Baht.
 - ❖ Following this, the Prachachat Party received donations from 7 donors, totaling 1.41 million Baht. The Move Forward Party had 44 donors, with a total donation of 654,940 Baht.

Economic News

- Prime Minister Srettha Thavisin will chair a mobile cabinet meeting in Nakhon Ratchasima province today.
 - ❖ The Ministry of Finance will propose the appointment of a new chairman of the Securities and Exchange Commission (SEC) to replace Phichit Akkarathit, whose 4-year term has ended.
 - The leading candidate for the position is Wisit Wisitsora-at, the Permanent Secretary of the Ministry of Digital Economy and Society, who is expected to become the new SEC chairman.



- ❖ Meanwhile, the National Economic and Social Development Council (NESDC), as the secretariat of the Joint Public-Private Committee for the Lower Northeastern Region 1, will acknowledge project proposals aimed at developing the southern Isaan region. These projects, with a total budget of 500 million Baht, are to be completed within one year.
- ❖ Additionally, there are eight key projects, proposed by the private sector, with a total budget of 247 million Baht.
- Today is 27th anniversary of the floating of Thai Baht. On July 2, 1997, under the Chavalit Yongchaiyuth government, the Thai Baht was floated after a failed defending of the currency against hedge funds who were betting against the fixed US\$ exchange rate of 25 Baht to the US\$.
 - ❖ The floating of the Thai Baht triggered what was known as the ‘Tom Yam Krung’ financial crisis that engulfed not just Thailand but Malaysia, Indonesia and South Korea.

- The Government Housing Bank (GH Bank) will extend the loan repayment period for its customers from 60-70 years to 80-85 years. This measure aims to ease financial burdens, especially for borrowers at risk of non-performing loans (NPLs) and those requiring special assistance.
 - ❖ Finance Minister Pichai Chunhavajira stated that this extension of the loan repayment period is intended to support low-income Thai citizens in maintaining homeownership. An 80-year repayment period remains shorter than in many other countries, where some offer up to 100 years.
 - ❖ He also said GH Bank plans to raise the housing loan limit, shifting focus from loans under 3 million Baht to homes valued between 5-10 million Baht. Currently, housing loans account for 30% of the country's GDP, and expanding this could potentially increase it to 50%, thereby stimulating the real estate market.
 - ❖ Additionally, GH Bank will review interest rate options, including zero interest for 6 to 12 months or fixed rates over longer terms, moving away from the current 1–3-year terms.
- Japan welcomed approximately 14.64 million foreign tourists, nearly matching Thailand's 14.76 million visitors in the first 5 months of 2024, according to Sittiwat Chiwarattanaporn, president of the Association of Thai Travel Agents (ATTA).
 - ❖ Sittiwat said throughout this year, Japan and Thailand are expected to vie for international tourists, with Japan benefiting significantly from its weakest yen in 38 years. Meanwhile, Thailand's diversity in tourism offerings remains a key selling point among foreign tourists.
- The 7% VAT collection will begin on July 5 and will remain in force until December 31 of this year, with the possibility of extension.
 - ❖ Under this measure, all imported products costing more than 1 Baht will be subject to VAT. The measure is temporary and is aimed at assessing its impact before further evaluation and potential new measures are considered.
 - ❖ Phantong Loykulnantara, the spokesperson of the Customs Department, said that for the first 8 months of the 2024 fiscal year (between October 2023 and May 2024), the import of products costing less than 1,500 Baht, which is currently exempt from VAT collection until the new measure comes into effect on July 5, amounted to 89 million pieces worth 26 billion Baht. The current estimation for the entire fiscal year ending in October is 30 billion Baht.

- The Board of Investment has approved investment privileges for 37 projects involving data centers and cloud computing services so far, the chief of the BOI Office said.
 - ❖ Narit Therdsteeerasukdi, secretary-general of the BOI Office, stated that the 37 approved projects have a combined investment value of 98.539 billion Baht. Most of these projects are located in Bangkok, Samut Prakan, Chon Buri, and Rayong.
 - ❖ A leader in data center investment is Amazon Web Services (AWS), which announced it would increase its investment in data centers in the kingdom to 200 billion Baht by 2037, Narit said. So far, AWS has invested approximately 25 billion Baht in building three data centers in Thailand.
 - ❖ Other major data center projects include NextDC from Australia, with an investment value of 13.7 billion Baht; STT GDC from Singapore (4.5 billion Baht); Evolution Data Centre from Singapore (4 billion Baht); Supernap (Switch) from the United States (3 billion Baht); Telehouse from Japan (2.7 billion Baht); and One Asia from Hong Kong (2 billion Baht).
 - ❖ Narit said Google and Microsoft have also announced plans to open data centers in Thailand, but their projects are currently being reviewed by the BOI and a team from Prime Minister Srettha Thavasin's office. Leading cloud services approved by the BOI include Alibaba Cloud with an investment value of 4 billion Baht and Huawei Technologies with an investment of 3 billion Baht.
- On the first trading day of Q3 2024, July 1, the Thai stock market saw the Stock Exchange of Thailand (SET) index close at 1,299.35 points, a decrease of 1.61 points or 0.12% from the previous trading day. The total trading value for the day was 29.731 billion Baht.
 - ❖ Notably, foreign investors made a net purchase of 337.97 million Baht, marking their first net purchase since May 21, 2024. Between May 21 and June 28, foreign investors consistently sold their holdings over 27 trading days, with a total value of 51.635 billion Baht.
 - ❖ However, the SET index remains devoid of new factors to drive it upward. The index was pressured by AOT, DELTA, BDMS, and BH stocks, leading to a decline in the market. Additionally, technical indicators suggested that the index is still in a downtrend, with risks from a strong U.S. dollar prompting foreign investors to reduce their investments in Asian stocks.
 - ❖ The outlook for today suggests a sideways-down movement for the SET index, as investors await domestic sentiment indicators, such as the Cabinet meeting and the Commerce Ministry's inflation report on July 5. The support level is expected at 1,288 points, with resistance levels at 1,304-1,308 points.

- To celebrate the opening of its first manufacturing plant in Thailand, BYD is offering discounts on its electric vehicles under the "BYD Thailand Factory Celebration" campaign. The price cuts are applicable from July 5 to 31, 2024.

- ❖ For instance, the New BYD ATTO 3 Dynamic (MY24) model is now priced at only 799,900 Baht, down from its original price of 899,900 Baht.

The BYD ATTO 3 Extended Range (MY23) model has also seen a significant price drop, now going for 859,900 Baht from its previous price of 1,199,900 Baht.

- ❖ However, this price reduction has also caused dissatisfaction among some early buyers who purchased the cars at a higher price.



General News

- Labubu's mascot from Beijing has arrived at Suvarnabhumi Airport. The mascot is here to attend the Welcome Ceremony of LABUBU arranged by the Ministry of Tourism and Sports and the Tourism Authority of Thailand (TAT), before playing a role in a new video to promote Thai tourism.
 - ❖ The decision to include Labubu's mascot in the new video came after TAT cooperated with POP MART to launch the Labubu Thailand Edition to mark 50 years of diplomatic ties between Thailand and China, and to encourage more Chinese tourists to visit Thailand. TAT is also collaborating with Trip.com and Tongcheng Travel to develop travel packages that follow Labubu's mascot's journey throughout Thailand.
