Thai Enquirer News Summary

Political News

- The market and the country awaits the ruling by the Constitutional Court on the fate of Prime Minister Srettha Thavisin, which is to be delivered tomorrow.
 - ❖ The case stems from the 40 former senators seeking the removal of Prime Minister Srettha tomorrow. The case concerns Srettha's appointment of Phichit Chuenban as Minister of the Prime Minister's Office, who was jailed a decade earlier therefore not eligible to be nominated as a Minister.

There are two possible outcomes:

- The court finds the appointment to be unlawful, leading to Srettha's immediate removal from office. In this scenario, the Cabinet would assume a caretaker role, with Deputy Prime Minister Phumtham Wechayachai serving as acting prime minister with the authority to dissolve the parliament.
- The court determines that the petition lacks sufficient grounds, allowing Srettha to remain in office.

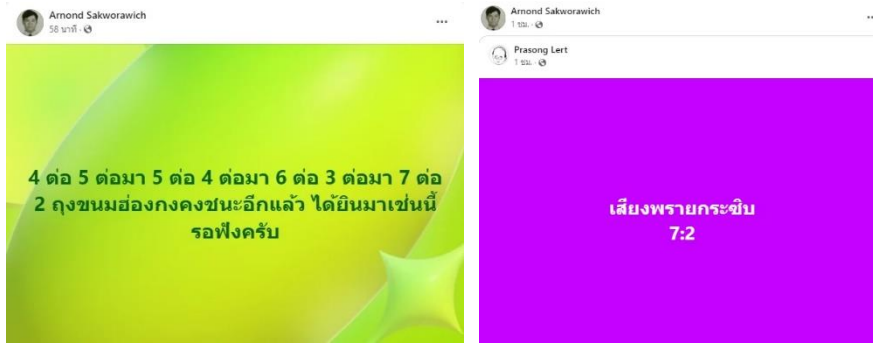

- Last night, Deputy Prime Minister Phumtham met with coalition party leaders at Government House. He affirmed that there are no concerns. The Prime Minister has instructed the coalition to remain calm and allow the judicial process to unfold.



- Arnonn Sakworawich, a lecturer at the Applied Statistics Department of the National Institute of Development Administration (NIDA), predicted on Facebook that the court will very likely rule in favor of Srettha.



- ❖ Meanwhile, the Prime Minister will inspect regions in the North, Central, and Northeast from August 15-19, hold a mobile Cabinet meeting in Phra Nakhon Si Ayutthaya on August 20, and continue field visits from August 21-31.
- People’s party, the reincarnation of the Move Forward party, has managed to garner more than 50,000 party members during the long-weekend drive to push for membership of the new party.
 - ❖ The party had set a target of 100,000 members but has so far managed to get halfway through it.
 - ❖ People’s party has managed to also get more than 20 million Baht in donations from their target of 10 million Baht.
 - ❖ Panika Wanich, the banned leader of Future Forward party, and a person who is behind the scene to support People’s party, has come out to congratulate the success of the membership and donation drive.

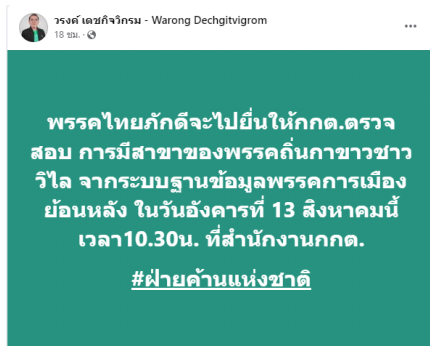


- Natthaphong Ruengpanyawut, a party-list MP and leader of the People's Party, addressed on the issue of being one of the 44 MPs investigated by the National Anti-Corruption Commission (NACC) over the proposed amendment to Section 112. He stated that the party has assembled a legal team to deal with the case and is not a big concern.

- ❖ In his initial tasks as the People's party leader, Natthaphong said he will focus on campaigning for the Ratchaburi Provincial Administrative Organization (PAO) election, the by-election for Phitsanulok MP in District 1, and restructuring the party in preparation for the 2027 election. A party meeting is scheduled for September 20.
- Pol. Gen. Watcharapon Prasanratchakit, Chairman of the NACC, stated that the NACC will submit the case directly to the Supreme Court, which will then conduct an investigation.
 - ❖ He assured that the NACC will ensure fairness in the process and will soon call the 44 MPs for clarification. However, it is unlikely that the case will be sent to the Supreme Court before his term ends in four weeks.



- The Election Commission (EC) confirmed yesterday the People's party (PP), the reincarnation of the disbanded Move Forward Party (MFP), had set up party branches as legally required.
 - ❖ EC secretary-general Sawaeng Boonmee said that Thin Kakao Chaovilai had registered all party branches as legally required, and the Office of the EC had concluded its enquiry.
 - ❖ The confirmation came after Thai Pakdee Party leader Warong Dechgitvigrom said he was preparing to file a petition against the PP over its predecessor, Thin Kakao Chaovilai, having failed to register enough party branches. He claimed Thin Kakao Chaovilai had registered two branches in the North and one in the Central Plains region, but the party did not have a single branch in the South or Northeast.
 - Under the law, he said that a political party ceases to exist legally if it doesn't have at least one branch in each of the four regions for a consecutive period of one year.
 - ❖ However, Warong will proceed with the planned petition and will submit it to the EC today.



- Warner Music Thailand apologized for a social media post that depicted the Constitutional Court's judges as rotten apples. They clarified that the post was made by an employee without prior approval from the management team.
 - ❖ On Friday, the Facebook page of Warner Music Thailand made a post to promote Spotify and YouTube links of a new song by its Thai artist Charli XCX, but the accompanying photos were of the nine judges in the Constitutional Court room reading the dissolution verdict against the Move Forward Party on Thursday. The new song by Charli is titled “Apple”.
 - ❖ The post combined two photos of the nine judges on their benches into one photo – one on top of the other with a caption in the middle, saying both in Thai and English “I think the apple’s rotten right to the core.”

We apologize for the incident again and will strengthen our processes and implement measures to prevent the recurrence of such incidents in the future.

- A recent Suan Dusit Poll revealed that Thai citizens are increasingly pessimistic about the current political situation. Conducted from August 7-9, 2024, the poll found that a significant 67.57% of respondents believe the political climate has worsened compared to previous periods.
 - ❖ Furthermore, 63.73% of respondents are dissatisfied with the Srettha government. 55.62% also believe that a cabinet reshuffle is necessary. 68.44% anticipate that the political situation will worsen.

- ❖ Suan Dusit Poll President, Pornpan Buathong, interpreted these findings as reflecting public anxiety and discontent with the government's performance, particularly in the economic sector. She said while the government has made some progress with the digital wallet policy, it is still insufficient to address the broader concerns.



- In Chaiyaphum Provincial Administrative Organization (PAO) election held on August 11, to replace Aram Lohwira, who resigned before completing his term, it turned out that Sureewan Nakasai, wife of Samrit Taensap, a Chaiyaphum MP from the Bhumjai Thai Party, received 210,103 votes, defeating Aram, who also contested but received 178,129 votes.

- ❖ The Election Commission will certify the results within 30 days if there are no objections.

Economic News

- At today's Cabinet meeting, chaired by Prime Minister Srettha Thavisin, the Ministry of Finance will present two proposals.
 - ❖ First, it will propose the launch of the Vayupak 1 Fund to general investors. Second, it will introduce a plan to establish the General Credit Guarantee Facility, which includes the creation of a National Credit Guarantee Agency.
 - ❖ This new facility will provide credit guarantees where borrowers pay a fee similar to purchasing insurance, and the government will contribute additional funding based on the borrower's risk level. The facility aims to address credit needs ranging from individual loans to business financing.
- Meanwhile today, Deputy Prime Minister and Finance Minister Pichai Chunhavajira will announce further details about the Vayupak 1 Fund. The new issuance, expected to launch towards the end of 2024, will be valued between 100-150 billion Baht.
 - ❖ This addition will increase the total size of the Vayupak Fund to 500 billion Baht, incorporating the existing 350 billion Baht fund and reaching the full amount approved by the Cabinet in 2013.
 - ❖ The initial offering price is set at 10 Baht per unit to make it accessible to individual investors, with no minimum or maximum purchase requirements. The units will be allocated in a small lot first method. The fund will guarantee returns comparable to those of 10-year government bonds. Investors who hold their units for 10 years will receive a 100% return of their principal, with returns paid twice a year.
 - ❖ Historically, the Vayupak Fund has provided an average return of 4%, excluding capital gains from the sale of units.



- The Finance Ministry is forming a committee tasked with developing policies and drafting legislation to establish the country as a financial hub.
 - ❖ According to Deputy Finance Minister Paopoom Rojanasakul, Finance Minister Pichai Chunhavajira signed a ministry order to establish the committee, with Paopoom as the chairman. The committee's first meeting is scheduled for this week. The new committee consists of 34 members, with Paopoom the chairman and the permanent finance secretary vice-chairman.
 - ❖ The committee will have the authority to study, recommend and formulate policies to promote Thailand as a financial centre, draft relevant laws and prepare plans for secondary legislation to present to the finance minister and cabinet. The goal to develop a global financial hub involves commitments to reform financial business regulations and new forms of benefits. The focus will be on five business sectors: banking, securities, derivatives, digital assets and insurance.



- According to the Trade Policy and Strategy Office (TPSO), the Thai average household expenditure in July was around 18,278 Baht. The largest expense categories were public transportation, vehicle purchases, fuel, and mobile phone costs, making up 23.48% of the total, averaging around 4,293 Baht.
 - ❖ For the first half of 2024, average monthly household expenses were 18,130 Baht similar to 18,131 Baht in the first half of 2023, due to government cost-of-living support.

- ❖ TPSO Director Poonpong Naiyanapakorn expected a slight increase in household expenses for the full year of 2024, in line with a modest rise in inflation, which is projected to be between 0.0% and 1.0%, with a median estimate of 0.5%.



- On Friday, August 9, the Stock Exchange of Thailand (SET) index closed at 1,297.07 points, up 0.82 points (+0.06%), with a trading value of 42.93 billion Baht. The market initially rose, supported by positive performance in Asian stock markets and buying interest in major stocks such as PTT, which benefited from rising oil and gas prices, as well as ADVANC and DELTA.
- ❖ However, the market faced pressure from domestic political factors, with investors awaiting the Constitutional Court's ruling on August 14 regarding the eligibility of Prime Minister Srettha Thavisin, concerning the appointment of Pichit Chuenban as a minister.

- Jakkaphong Jakrajutatip, CEO and Managing Director of JKN Global Group Plc (JKN), reported to the Stock Exchange of Thailand on the progress of the legal case between JKN and TCJ Social Media Group Co., Ltd. (TCG).
- ❖ Previously, TCG had filed a defamation lawsuit against JKN and Jakkaphong, seeking 1 billion Baht in damages. However, Jakkaphong said the Criminal Court has eventually dismissed the case. In response, JKN has filed a criminal complaint

against TCG for false litigation and defamation, with the Criminal Court scheduled to review the case on August 19.










