Thai Enquirer News Summary

Economic News

- Google is set to invest US\$ 1 billion in building data centers in Thailand. This investment, which includes a data center and cloud region, is expected to create an average of 14,000 jobs from 2025 to 2029 and contribute approximately \$4 billion to Thailand's GDP by 2029.
 - ❖ The facilities will be located in Bangkok and Chonburi.
 - ❖ After meeting with Ruth Porat, President and Chief Investment Officer of Alphabet and Google, Prime Minister Paetongtarn Shinawatra expressed the government's

appreciation for Google's support of the Cloud First Policy. This policy aims to enhance data management, streamline government operations, and provide safer, more inclusive services for Thai citizens.

- ❖ She also highlighted the ongoing collaboration between Google and the Board of Investment (BoI) to establish Thailand's first data center.



- The Bank of Thailand (BoT) has acknowledged its intervention in the value of the Baht during a period marked by significant strength and high volatility, which has led to an increase in international reserves.
 - ❖ Chayawadee Chaianan, the BoT spokesperson, noted that the rapid appreciation of the Baht is partly due to the weakening US Dollar, following the release of slowing U.S. economic data and unexpected interest rate cuts by the Federal Reserve. Additionally, the performance of the yen has been affected by comments from high-ranking officials regarding monetary policy, leading markets to anticipate potential adjustments in the Bank of Japan's rates. The yuan has also strengthened due to announced economic stimulus measures that boosted investor sentiment, further contributing to the rise of the Baht and other regional currencies.
 - ❖ The BoT is closely monitoring the situation to mitigate adverse effects during volatile periods, with its interventions reflected in the increase in international reserves. While the Baht remains strong, it is not at its peak; Malaysia's currency has appreciated by 11%, positioning the Baht as second or third among regional currencies. Factors such as improved government stability and economic stimulus measures have positively influenced market sentiment, contributing to increases in stock prices and gold values.



- The 3.75 trillion Baht budget bill for fiscal 2025 has been announced in the Royal Gazette. The proposed budget is the highest expense budget on record, with a fiscal deficit of 865.7 billion Baht, the largest to date.
 - ❖ Approximately 908 billion Baht is allocated for investment, a 27.9% increase from the 2024 budget. Around 152.7 billion Baht is earmarked for the digital wallet handout.
- Latest flooding has cost nearly 30 billion Baht in damages, the Thai Chamber of Commerce reported.
 - ❖ The chamber said landslides and flash floods that impacted 33 provinces in northern and northeastern Thailand have resulted in estimated damages worth 29.85 billion Baht, about 0.17% of GDP, affecting around 3 million rai of land, with the agricultural sector suffering the most at 24.55 billion Baht.
- Piyasvasti Amranand, Chief Executive of the Thai Airways International Plc (THAI) rehabilitation plan, announced that the company has submitted a securities offering statement and a draft prospectus to the Securities and Exchange Commission (SEC) and the Stock Exchange of Thailand.
 - ❖ This marks the beginning of its capital restructuring process, which involves converting debt to equity and offering additional common shares as part of the rehabilitation plan. The restructuring must be completed by December 31, 2024, to ensure that THAI's shareholders' equity becomes positive, as it currently stands at a negative 40.427 billion Baht.
 - ❖ Once this goal is achieved, the company can petition the Central Bankruptcy Court to terminate its rehabilitation. Additionally, THAI aims to have its shares resume trading on the Stock Exchange of Thailand by the second quarter of 2025.



- Today, October 1, the Vayupak Fund 1 (VAYU 1) is set to begin injecting investment into the Stock Exchange of Thailand, ahead of its Unit Type A trading debut on October 7.

- ❖ Chavinda Hanratanakool, Managing Director of Krungthai Asset Management (KTAM), the fund manager for VAYU 1, stated that starting from this month, the fund will focus on investing in companies with strong fundamentals, good liquidity, long-term stability, sustainable operations, and good corporate governance.
- ❖ This includes companies in the SET100 index that have received an “A” or higher SET ESG ratings, as well as companies outside the SET100 that have achieved higher SET ESG ratings. Additionally, the fund may consider investing in infrastructure funds, property funds, and real estate investment trusts (REITs) with high returns or strong growth potential.
- Yesterday, the Stock Exchange of Thailand (SET) index closed at 1,448.83 points, down by 1.32 points (-0.09%) with a trading value of 52.87 billion Baht.
 - ❖ The market had no new developments, and selling pressure from profit-taking was present. Concerns about intervention to control the rapidly strengthening Baht have not yet affected the market.
 - ❖ As for today's outlook, the market is expected to move sideways within a range, with attention on U.S. economic data reports. Domestically, focus will be on inflows from the Vayupak Fund and additional economic stimulus measures from the government. The support level is set at 1,435-1,440 points, while resistance is seen at 1,455-1,460 points.

- Yesterday, shares of Thonburi Healthcare Group Plc (THG) plunged by over 5.24% before closing at 19.90 Baht, down by 1.10 Baht, with a trading value of 43.59 million Baht. Investors are concerned about the risks surrounding THG shares held by Dr. Boon Vanasin, the former chairman and founder of THG, who owns 184 million shares.
 - ❖ There is speculation that creditors may force the sale of these shares, as Dr. Boon pledged them as collateral for loans. This situation could impact THG shareholders, including Ramkhamhaeng Hospital Plc (RAM), the largest shareholder of THG with a 24.59% stake.

- Yesterday, the gold market adjusted prices eight times, dropping by more than 550 Baht per Baht of gold.
 - ❖ As a result, the buying price for gold bars was 40,300 Baht, while the selling price was 40,400 Baht. For gold ornaments, the buying price was 39,567.60 Baht, with a selling price of 40,900 Baht per Baht-weight. The spot gold price was 2,650.50, and the exchange rate was 32.18 Baht per U.S. dollar.
 - ❖ This decline followed a significant drop in global gold prices, further exacerbated by the continuing strengthening of the Baht, which broke through the 33.00 and 32.50 Baht per dollar levels. The Baht reached its strongest point in 31 months at 32.36 Baht per U.S. dollar, marking its highest level since late February 2022, or in 2 years and 7 months.
 - ❖ However, the gold market still shows a long-term upward trend, supported by expectations of significant interest rate cuts by the U.S. Federal Reserve in November, as well as ongoing tensions in the Middle East.

Political News

- Paetongtarn Shinawatra, the Prime Minister and Chair of the Police Commission, has announced a special meeting of the Police Commission scheduled for Monday, October 7, at the National Police Office. The meeting will focus on the special agenda to select and appoint the new Commissioner of the National Police.



- ❖ Since Pol Gen Torsak Sukvimol, the current national police chief, retired on September 30, the Police Commission must choose a new commissioner. Qualified candidates include:
 - Pol Gen Kittirat Phanphet, Deputy National Police Chief, retiring in 2026
 - Pol Gen Kraibhun Thrawasong, National Police Inspector, retiring in 2025
 - Pol Gen Thana Chuwong, Deputy National Police Chief, retiring in 2026
- ❖ It is expected that Pol Gen Kittirat will be proposed, the most senior officer, for the position.



- The Senate voted 167 -19 to uphold the recommendation of its committee reviewing the referendum bill, supporting the retention of the double-majority rule, in contrast to the resolution passed by the lower house.

- ❖ The House of Representatives had voted to replace the double-majority rule with a simple majority, and the bill had already passed its first reading in the Senate. However, the Senate's committee, established following the first reading, proposed amendments to reinstate the double-majority rule, resulting in today's reversal.
 - ❖ This development suggests that the first referendum on amending the junta-drafted constitution may be delayed beyond February, as a bicameral conference committee will need to be convened to reconcile the differing versions of the bill.
 - ❖ The Senate will send the draft back to the House of Representatives to determine whether it agrees with the Senate's amendments or will uphold its original resolution. If the House disagrees with the Senate, a joint committee will be established to find a resolution.
- Meanwhile the ruling Pheu Thai Party will meet with its coalition partners to push for a new constitution in response to the Senate voting to retain the present double majority requirement needed to win a referendum on a new supreme law.
 - ❖ Minister to the Prime Minister's Office Chousak Sirinil said that a joint committee is expected to be formed to thrash out differences of opinion between the Lower and Upper Houses on the size of the majority needed to pass a referendum on the government's rewrite of the 2017 constitution.

But this could delay the time frame for a national referendum, tentatively scheduled for Feb 2 next year, the same day as the election of members of provincial administrative organisations.



- Today, the Cabinet meeting will consider an agenda proposed by the Disaster Relief Operations Center to adjust the compensation criteria for victims of flooding and landslides.
 - ❖ They will seek approval to use the emergency reserve fund in the 2025 budget to modify the current compensation amounts of 5,000, 7,000, and 9,000 Baht per household.

- ❖ Among other interesting agenda items, the Prime Minister's Office will propose the appointment of political officials within the Prime Minister's Office.
- Political activist Ruangkrai Leekitwattana says he will ask the Election Commission (EC) to investigate Prime Minister Paetongtarn Shinawatra's ethical conduct over her shares in Alpine Golf and Sports Club. The company bought a controversial monastic plot in Pathum Thani, which houses Alpine Golf Club and a residential complex.
 - ❖ Ruangkrai said he would ask the EC to investigate whether Ms Paetongtarn violated Section 160 (4) of the constitution, which stipulates that cabinet ministers must be evidently honest, and Section 8 of the ethical standards.
 - ❖ He said Ms Paetongtarn transferred her shares in the company to her mother, Khunying Potjaman Damapong, on Sept 3. He cited copies of documents from the Department of Business Development, which show that the company held a shareholders meeting on April 30. The shareholders on that date included Ms Paetongtarn, who held 22.41 million shares with certificate numbers 5229001-747000000.



- Former Yellow Shirts leader Sondhi Limthongkul stated that his group would undertake three actions from now until the first quarter of 2025, including street protests. The three actions he mentioned are as follows:
 - Filing a complaint for Prime Minister Paetongtarn Shinawatra to follow up on the investigation into the assassination attempt against him in April 2009. Arrest warrants have been issued, but so far, no one has been arrested.
 - Filing a complaint for Prime Minister Paetongtarn to investigate illegal Myanmar immigrants who are coming to work in Thailand without permits, including street vendors. He claimed that Samut Prakan's Mahachai Sub-District is now heavily populated by Myanmar nationals, and there are schools that sing the Myanmar national anthem during morning assembly. Only Thai citizens should receive the 400 Baht minimum wage, while Myanmar workers should earn less because they are not Thai.

- Compiling all the wrongdoings of the current government, including policy failures and ethical misconduct issues, to demonstrate to the public why this government should no longer be in power.

❖ He said, "This will be the last march of my life."



General News

- Crime Suppression Division officers arrested the couple, Kornkanok Suwanbut and her husband Kanpon Rueangaram, aka “Mae Tuck” and “Pa Beer”, searched their residence in Ramindra Soi 65 for additional evidence.
 - ❖ The couple faces charges of deceiving consumers, putting distorted facts into a computer system, advertising falsely and causing misunderstanding on their products’ quality, police said. They were escorted to the Crime Suppression Division in Chatuchak to undergo legal procedures.

- ❖ The duo were accused of selling gold ornaments that had less gold content than originally advertised. Hundreds of buyers flocked to their shop in Bangkok last Monday, demanding a refund. They were told that they would only get a full refund if they returned everything, including the free gift, and signed a document agreeing not to take legal action against the couple.
- ❖ During initial questioning, both suspects denied all charges and stated they would fight the case in court. Last night, they had to remain in custody after police opposed their bail request during the investigation, and they will be formally detained this morning.



- Northern parts of Thailand, which has just managed to see flood waters recede, has been warned that more rain could be on the way up until October 3, 2024 and those living in the flood prone areas to be careful and remain in the shelters (for the time being).
