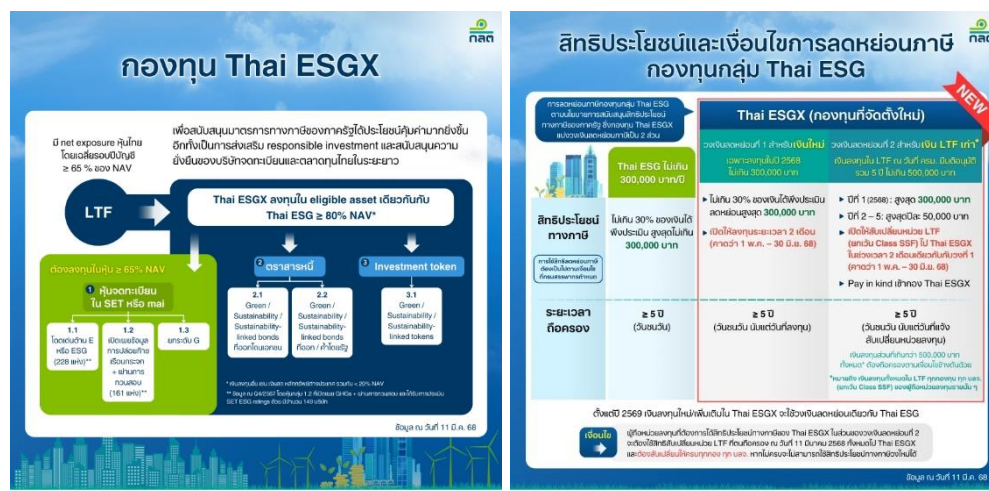
Economic News

- Deputy Prime Minister and Finance Minister Pichai Chunhavajira stated that the Ministry of Finance is preparing an executive decree to grant the Securities and Exchange Commission (SEC) authority in critical cases. The decree is expected to be presented to the Cabinet next week to restore investor confidence.
 - ❖ SEC Secretary-General Pornanong Busratrakul said the SEC has proposed amendments to the Securities and Exchange Act to grant officials the power to conduct investigations with police or special case investigators for certain criminal offenses. This would allow direct prosecution in high-impact cases, such as the STARK stock scandal, which significantly affected investors.

- ❖ Reports indicate that as many as 11 listed companies have faced trading issues, impacting investor confidence. These include MORE, STARK, ALL, JKN, ITD, SABUY, EA, NEXT, THG, RS, and YGG.



- The Cabinet has approved the Thai ESG Extra (ESGX) initiative, allowing investors to transfer their existing Long-Term Equity Fund (LTF) investments into a new fund, with a tax deduction of up to 500,000 baht. Investors can also invest an additional 300,000 baht in the new fund, with tax benefits.
- ❖ Pornchai Thiraveja, spokesperson for the Ministry of Finance, stated that the new regulation aims to enhance the stability of the Thai capital market by helping keep funds within the Thai Stock Exchange while supporting environmental, social, and governance (ESG) investments and providing investors with more sustainable investment options.



- The 10,000 baht handout cannot be used for tuition fees or phone bills, Deputy Finance Minister Paopoom Rojanasakul said, contradicting the ministry's statement.



- ❖ Deputy Finance Minister Julapun Amornvivat blamed reporters for the confusion, claiming they asked questions too quickly and confrontationally, and should have submitted questions in advance.
- ❖ The press conference on Monday followed a meeting where the government's economic stimulation committee approved Phase 3 of the handout. The ministry did not ask reporters to submit questions beforehand and did not provide any press release, even though the ministry had all the information in hand. The ministry had also stated that people aged 16-20, mostly students, could use the handout to help their parents with education costs. Even the government's own website mentioned that the money could be used for tuition fees. However, they have now reversed their position and blamed reporters' questions about their own policy.



- Prime Minister Paetongtarn Shinawatra posted on X that Labor Minister Phiphat Ratchakitprakarn had reported on the ministry's study on the impact of a planned minimum wage increase in 2025. The Wage Committee is set to meet on March 12 to discuss the proposed nationwide minimum wage of 400 baht.



- ❖ Minister Phiphat reaffirmed that the wage committee meeting on March 12 will address the nationwide implementation of the 400-baht minimum wage. Since some areas have already adopted this rate as of January 1, 2025, the government aims to roll it out nationwide by May 1, which is Labor Day, as a gift to workers.
- Yesterday Social Security Office Secretary-General Marasri Jairangsee announced that the Social Security Board has unanimously approved the principle of adjusting the pension formula for insured persons under Sections 33 and 39.
 - ❖ The office will refine the details of the new formula, called CARE, which has been under study since 2020 and aims to increase pensions in line with inflation. Currently, 800,000 retirees receive pensions, with around 100,000 new recipients added annually.
 - ❖ A 30-day public hearing will be conducted before the proposal is submitted to the Social Security Board by May 2025. The amendments are expected to be finalized by June 2025.

- The Ministry of Tourism and Sports plans to submit its proposal to attract renowned global musicians to perform in Thailand to the Cabinet in April, Minister Sorawong Thienthong said.
 - ❖ The ministry and the Tourism Authority of Thailand are in talks with representatives of these musicians, and the budget will be proposed along with the plan. This follows Prime Minister Paetongtarn Shinawatra's instruction for the ministry to secure big events for Thailand. It also follows Lady Gaga's

announcement of a four-day concert in Singapore in May, her only stop in Asia for her MAYHEM tour, skipping Thailand.

- ❖ Additionally The Ministry of Tourism and Sports will begin negotiations in the next 1-2 months to renew the contract for hosting the MotoGP, aiming for a 5-year extension, similar to the previous agreement.



- As of March 10, the Ministry of Tourism and Sports reported that Thailand had welcomed a total of 7.66 million international tourists from January 1 to March 9, generating approximately 375 billion baht in revenue.

- ❖ The top five source countries were :

- China 1,121,207 visitors
- Malaysia 938,173 visitors
- Russia 558,866 visitors
- South Korea 419,759 visitors
- India 408,543 visitors



- The Cabinet approved extending the discount of 19.05 satang per unit for households using up to 300 units of electricity per month until April.
 - ❖ The current rate is 4.15 baht per unit. About 21.3 million people are expected to receive assistance, with a total budget of 1.7 billion baht from the 2025 mid-year central budget under the emergency or necessary reserve fund.



- Meanwhile Dr. Phuphat Leesombatpaiboon, Secretary-General of the Energy Regulatory Commission (ERC), announced that the ERC meeting on March 5 approved a public hearing on the fuel tariff (FT) for the May–August period, which will take place from March 11 to 24.
 - ❖ The hearing will consider three scenarios.
 - The first scenario sets the FT rate at 137.39 satang per unit, combined with the base electricity rate of 3.78 baht per unit, bringing the average electricity cost to 5.16 baht per unit, a 24% increase from the current 4.15 baht per unit. This option would fully repay outstanding costs of 71.74 billion baht to the Electricity Generating Authority of Thailand (EGAT) and 15.08 billion baht in outstanding natural gas procurement costs.
 - The second scenario sets the FT rate at 116.37 satang per unit, bringing the total electricity cost to 4.95 baht per unit, a 19% increase from the current rate. Under this option, EGAT would recover all fuel and electricity purchase costs by August 2025.
 - The third scenario keeps the FT rate at 36.72 satang per unit, maintaining the electricity rate at 4.15 baht per unit. EGAT would gradually recover 14.59 billion baht in outstanding costs, but by August 2025, it would still be carrying an outstanding cost of 60.47 billion baht on behalf of consumers.

- The Stock Exchange of Thailand (SET) index closed yesterday at 1,187.63 points, up 10.19 points (+0.87%), with a trading value of 49.52 billion baht. The index was volatile, initially declining in the morning before rebounding into positive territory in the afternoon.
 - ❖ Buying interest in large-cap stocks increased following clearer details on the establishment of the Thai ESGX fund, which will help support funds previously allocated to LTFs. This development was seen as a positive factor for the market. However, concerns over a potential U.S. economic recession and ongoing trade policy uncertainties continued to add volatility to the stock market.
 - ❖ For today's outlook, the index is expected to move sideways, with resistance at 1,200 points and support at 1,180 points.

- Naruchol Damrongpiyawut, the newly appointed CEO of Gunkul Engineering Plc (GUNKUL), has announced the company's goal to become the most recognized company in green energy and infrastructure across Asia.
 - ❖ For 2025, GUNKUL aims for revenue growth of 10-15%, with a three-year target exceeding 35 billion baht. This growth will be driven by continued expansion in clean energy production, backed by an investment budget of 12 billion baht. Additionally, the company is exploring further investments in overseas power plants, including in Vietnam, Taiwan, and the Philippines.

- ❖ Regarding the government's policy to reduce electricity costs for public relief, GUNKUL stated that its business operations will not be affected, as the policy primarily focuses on setting natural gas prices for power plants.



Political News

- The Secretary-General of the House of Representatives, Aphet Sukhanan, commented on the opposition leader's objection to removing former Prime Minister Thaksin Shinawatra from the motion for a no-confidence debate.



- ❖ He stated that the deadline for the opposition to submit the revised motion is not fixed. If the debate is set for March 24 as reported, the opposition should submit the revised motion to the House by March 17 to allow time for it to be

communicated to the Cabinet before their meeting on March 18. If submitted after March 17, the House can still forward it to the Cabinet, depending on whether the Cabinet is ready to respond.

- ❖ Previously, the working group of House Speaker Wan Muhamad Noor Matha confirmed that motions referring to outsiders do not comply with parliamentary rules and the constitution. They explained that motions mentioning outsiders from 1986 were protected by parliamentary privileges and could not be litigated. However, under the current constitution, such motions are subject to legal action.
- Meanwhile Natthaphong Ruengpanyawut, a list MP and leader of the People's Party, the opposition leader, stated that he would like to wait for the parliamentary meeting on March 12 to directly express concerns to the Speaker of the House, based on the reasons outlined in the objection letter.
 - ❖ He added that there is still time for discussions within this week and hopes the Speaker will remain neutral.



- Prime Minister Paetongtarn Shinawatra stated that Thaksin has not made any comments on the no-confidence debate motion. She emphasized that the opposition should focus on facts and not their emotions.
 - ❖ When asked if Thaksin should hold a public press conference, Paetongtarn replied, "What would he explain? Thaksin is the father of the 31st Prime Minister, not a prime minister himself. Why should he be debated or hold a press conference? If Hollywood invites him to be an actor, then perhaps he could have a press conference, but he's too old to be a star."



- Pakornwut Udompipatskul, Deputy Leader of the People’s Party, said that all MPs caught smoking e-cigarettes in smoking zones inside Parliament will be investigated by the Parliament’s Ethics Committee. His comments followed a photo showing People's Party Bangkok MP Chorayuth Chaturapornprasit smoking an e-cigarette in a smoking zone at Parliament. This came after another photo in December showed a different People's Party MP doing the same.
 - ❖ Pakornwut said the party would follow its internal processes to investigate. He understands the matter has been brought to the Ethics Committee and noted that it’s not just the People’s Party involved. Other MPs from different parties have also committed similar acts, but their photos haven’t been released.
 - ❖ When asked about the government’s crackdown and calls to legalize e-cigarettes, Pakornwut said that a report from the ad hoc committee on regulating e-cigarettes will be presented to the House on March 13. He said it’s a good opportunity for the House to consider the issue, as society becomes more aware of it.



General News

- The Football Association of Thailand (FA Thailand) plans to sue its former president, Pol. Gen. Somyot Poompanmoung, after the Supreme Court ordered the association to pay 360 million baht in compensation to Siam Sport Syndicate for copyright and contract violations.

- ❖ FA Thailand’s current president, Nualphan Lamsam, said she would sue Somyot and the executive board from his time under Section 76 of the Civil and Commercial Code, as the debt resulted from their decisions.
- ❖ The case began in 2016 when Somyot ended the association’s contract with Siam Sport, which held the rights to broadcast major football tournaments in Thailand. Somyot claimed the contract was unfair because Siam Sport was making more profit and it wasn’t benefiting the association. Meanwhile Cineplex, a film production company, filed a lawsuit against Siam Sport, leading Siam Sport to countersue FA Thailand and 20 individuals for copyright and contract violations.
- ❖ The Central Intellectual Property and International Trade Court ordered Siam Sport to pay Cineplex 240 million baht and FA Thailand to pay 50 million baht to Siam Sport. After appeals, the Specialized Appeal Court raised the amount FA Thailand had to pay to 450 million baht. The Supreme Court later reduced the compensation to 360 million baht.



- The fire at Ramathibodi Hospital has been put out, with no reports of fatalities so far. The fire was reported around 7:20 p.m. last night in a nine-story building, with floors 1-4 used for operations and floors 5–9 for patient accommodation.
 - ❖ The incident happened on the second floor of the building’s left side. Patients from the left side of all floors were moved to the right side and evacuated.



- ❖ The Faculty of Medicine Ramathibodi Hospital reported that all services in Building 1 are temporarily suspended.

เนื่องด้วยในวันที่ 11 มีนาคม 2568 เวลาประมาณ 19:20 น. เพ็ญพุดคุณกรีนและเพ็ญกมลรัตน์ อธิการบดี (อาคาร 1) โรงพยาบาลรามาธิบดี จึงได้แจ้งเหตุกับเจ้าหน้าที่ดับเพลิงและกู้ภัย เพื่อเข้าระงับเหตุ และเจ้าหน้าที่ของโรงพยาบาลได้เก็บข้อเท็จจริงจากผู้เกี่ยวข้องและประสานที่รับการรักษาผู้ป่วยในอาคารหลักออกนอกพื้นที่ทันทีเพื่อหลีกเลี่ยงน้ำดับเพลิงและกู้ภัยชำระล้างเหตุ โดยปัจจุบันสามารถควบคุมสถานการณ์ได้แล้วเนื่องจากยังมีปริมาณผู้ป่วยของโรงพยาบาลยังมีจำนวนมากจึงขาดการดูแลนี้ต่อไป

ในระยะแรก โรงพยาบาลรามาธิบดีจะงดให้บริการภายในอาคารหลัก (อาคาร 1) ทั้งหมด ทั้งการรักษาพยาบาลผู้ป่วยนอก รวมถึงงดการผ่าตัด เป็นเวลา 48 ชั่วโมง เพื่อตรวจสอบความพร้อมของอาคารและงดให้บริการผู้ป่วยหนักที่ห้องฉุกเฉิน สำหรับงานเวชระเบียน การรับฝากศพและจุดกระจายเลือดจะให้บริการที่อาคารศูนย์ประชุมอิมพีดเนียม ส่วนอาคารศูนย์ประชุมอิมพีดเนียมจะงดให้บริการตามปกติ หากมีความจำเป็นทางโรงพยาบาลรามาธิบดีจะแจ้งให้ทราบต่อไป หรือหากท่านมีความจำเป็นต้องสอบถามข้อมูลการให้บริการในระหว่างนี้ได้ที่ Call Center 0-2201-1000 และ 0-2200-3000

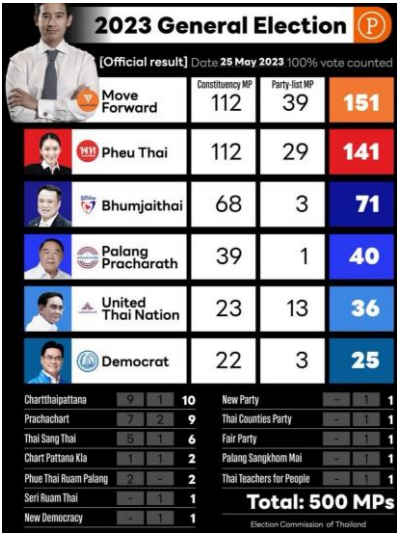
