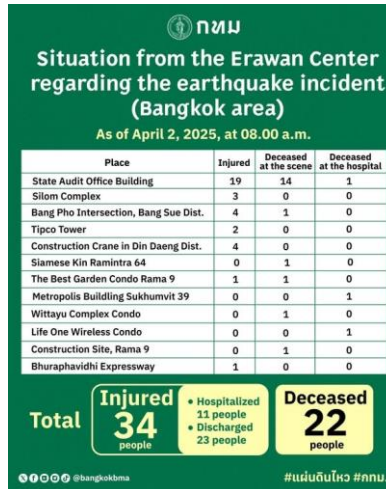

Thai Enquirer News Summary

Earthquake Tragedy

- The death toll from the collapsed building keeps rising as hours pass by since the March 28, 2025, tremors that was felt in Bangkok and caused an ongoing construction of the 'Office of the Auditor General (OAG)' building.
 - ❖ Early this morning another body was recovered. The deceased person was a woman. Total deceased now stand at 22 as of 08:00 hrs.
 - ❖ There are still 72 people missing in the collapsed building and nearly 4 days later the probability of life seems very low.



- An X-ray image from U.S. military search tools has revealed bodies trapped in the rubble of the collapsed State Audit Office building.
 - ❖ Deputy Bangkok Governor Thavida Kamolvej stated that it remains unclear if all 70 points detected in the scan represent the missing, as the building's complex structure makes pinpointing exact locations difficult. However, standard scanning equipment has identified 6 points believed to be human bodies, and teams are working to access them.
 - ❖ These 6 points are clustered together, and moving parts of the building will require specialized tools. It remains uncertain if the detected shapes still show signs of life, as the scanner only identifies shapes.
 - ❖ Thavida emphasized that they are not concluding all the missing have perished, and scanning will continue using all available technologies. Initially, teams were unable to reach the areas where life signs were detected, and no bodies were found. People are suspected to be trapped between floors 17 and 21, where work was ongoing. Around 70 people are believed to be in this area.



- China Railway No. 10 Engineering Group, a subsidiary of the Chinese state-owned China State Railway Group, secured 14 government contracts in Thailand worth 7.2 billion Baht between the 2019 and 2022 fiscal years.

- ❖ The subsidiary, established in 2018, was part of the ITD-CREC joint venture that built the collapsed State Audit Office building, with Italian-Thai Development as the other partner.

- ❖ China Railway Number 10 has participated in government projects through joint ventures, initially bidding on medium-sized projects worth around 100 million Baht and later moving on to larger projects worth 300 to 500 million Baht. It eventually ventured into major government concession projects valued at around 1 billion Baht.

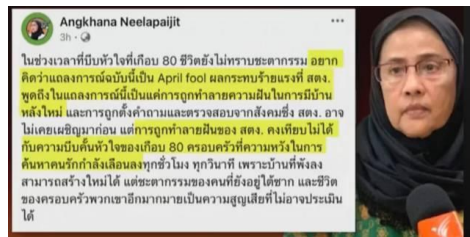
- The “CSI LA” Facebook page revealed that China Railway No. 10 (Thailand) won several government construction projects by hiding the company name, such as the construction of the Minburi Criminal Court and the outpatient building at Songkhla Hospital.



- The investigation into China Railway No. 10 Engineering Group's alleged use of Thai nominees to hold shares has expanded to include 13 other linked companies and 4 others

located in the same building as the company, according to Deputy Commerce Minister Napintorn Srisunpang.

- ❖ A high-level committee, including the National Anti-Corruption Commission (NACC), Royal Thai Police, and Revenue Department, is leading the investigation and has been instructed to conclude within 7 days.
 - ❖ Regarding Thai nationals holding shares in the company, Napintorn confirmed that some do, but said the final conclusion is pending. Legal action will be taken if violations are found.
 - ❖ The ministry is also working with the Department of Lands to cross-check company and land ownership records in real time, ensuring that nominee arrangements do not harm Thailand. Napintorn noted that more than 20,000 companies are under examination as part of the investigation.
 - ❖ A task force, led by the Permanent Secretary, is currently investigating the case and is set to present its findings in a meeting on April 4.
- Senator Angkhana Neelapajit posted a message from the Auditor General to its staff, which did not mention the over 80 people affected by the collapse of the new building project at the Office of the Auditor General (OAG) on March 28.



- ❖ Angkhana commented that she hoped the statement was an April Fool's joke. She emphasized that the OAG should focus more on others and less on itself, and should clarify any doubts the public has.
- ❖ Later, Montien Charoenphol, the Auditor General, admitted that the document was an internal communication meant to offer support to OAG staff, to keep them calm. He also stated that there would be no further communication with the public on the matter.

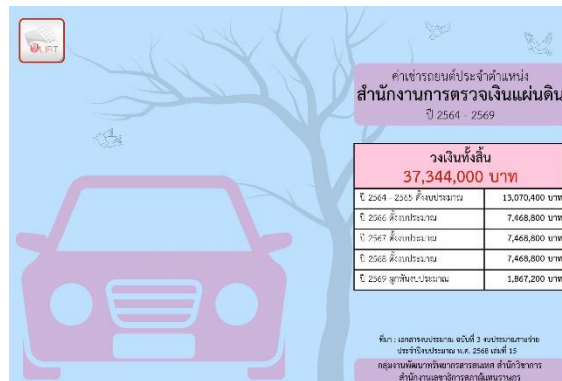


สุดสลดหายใจลึกๆ กุมมือกินไข่ต้ม และก้าวไปพร้อมๆกัน

เหตุการณ์ที่เกิดขึ้นเมื่อช่วงบ่ายของวันศุกร์ที่ ๒๘ มีนาคม ๒๕๖๕ ที่ผ่านมา ส่งผลกระทบที่ร้ายแรงที่สุดเท่าที่สำนักงานการตรวจเงินแผ่นดินของเรายเคยประสบมา เหตุการณ์นี้บอกเราถึงความฝันของเรานับการมีบ้านหลังใหม่ ที่ทุกคนใฝ่ฝันอยากมี หวังจะช่วยนำชีวิตแล้ว ยังไม่เหลือความน่าเชื่อถือ ศักดิ์ศรีและเกียรติภูมิที่ร่วมกันสั่งสมกันมา โดยยากที่จะหวนคืนเสียได้ ซึ่งร้ายยิ่งเท่าเหตุการณ์ครั้งนี้เองทำให้หลายคนอยู่ในภาวะวิตกกังวล สับสน ไม่นิ่งนอนใจความปลอดภัยในการทำงานและการใช้ชีวิต

แน่นอนว่าไม่มีใครอยากให้เกิดเหตุการณ์นี้เกิดขึ้น หลายคนอยากให้เป็นเพียงแค่ฝันร้าย แต่เมื่อมันเกิดขึ้นแล้ว และเราไม่สามารถย้อนเวลากลับไปแก้ไขอะไรได้ สิ่งเดียวที่ทำได้คือการให้กำลังใจซึ่งกันและกัน ร่วมแรงร่วมใจกันมองไปข้างหน้าเพื่อก้าวข้ามช่วงเวลาที่ยากลำบากและลี้ภัยนี้ไปด้วยกัน

- The Office of the Auditor General (OAG) spent 37.3 million Baht on car rentals for officials, according to research by the Legislative Institutional Repository of Thailand.
 - ❖ STRONG Association Against Corruption's research also showed that they were planning to spend 97,900 Baht on an office chair, 90,000 Baht for a dining table, 165,000 Baht on a sofa, and 165,000 Baht on a carpet for its new building before it collapsed after the earthquake last Friday.
 - ❖ Car rental budget breakdown:
 - In 2021-2022, the budget was set at 13.1 million Baht.
 - In 2023, the budget was set at 7.5 million Baht.
 - In 2024, the budget was set at 7.5 million Baht.
 - In 2025, the budget was set at 7.5 million Baht.
 - In 2026, the budget commitment was 1.9 million Baht.



Economic News

- The world awaits the ‘Trump Trade Barriers’ that are set to be announced at 02:00 hrs. of April 3, 2025 (Thai time).
 - ❖ There is no use speculating on the possibilities because nobody knows what the outcome is likely to be.
- Piyasak Manason, Head of Economic Research at InnovestX Securities, stated that the recent earthquake has had no significant impact on Thailand’s economy. However, the

trade war poses a greater risk, and attention should be given to the potential “Trump Tariffs 2.0” on April 2 (Today).

- ❖ The brokerage projected four scenarios for US reciprocal tariffs on Thai products.
 - The first is the US maintaining the current tariff for all imports from Thailand, which it estimates at a 40% likelihood, resulting Thai GDP expansion of 2.4-2.5%.
 - An increase to an average 6% tariff, which has a 30% probability, would reduce GDP to around 2%.
 - While a 10% average tariff has a 20% likelihood and would shrink GDP to 1.7% in 2025.
 - For the worst case, which is an average tariff of more than 10%, there is a 10% probability and GDP could decline to 1.3%.

- ❖ InnovestX Securities has lowered its 2025 target for the Thai stock index to 1,350 points from the previous 1,550 points, citing external pressures and trade policy uncertainties affecting economic growth. However, the lower valuation has made the market more attractive, with potential for a rebound in the second quarter of 2025.



- The Ministry of Tourism and Sports reported that from January 1 to March 31, 2025, Thailand welcomed over 9.54 million foreign tourists, generating 462 billion Baht in revenue.

- ❖ The top 5 visitor nationalities were
 - China with 1,331,434 arrivals
 - Malaysia with 1,153,496
 - Russia with 722,202

- India with 543,770
- South Korea with 497,930.



❖ However, in the past week,

- Foreign arrivals were at 584,851 a 0.77% decrease from the previous week
 - ✓ Malaysian tourists increased by 42.19%
 - ✓ UK rose by 18.68%
 - ✓ Russian arrivals dipped by 10.94%
 - ✓ Indian visitors fell by 6.58%
 - ✓ Chinese tourists declined by 3.83%.



- The Cabinet has approved the first phase of the ‘Homes for Thais’ pilot project, which includes 5,700 affordable housing units in Bangkok, Thonburi, Pathum Thani, and Chiang Mai.

❖ The project aims to develop land owned by the State Railway of Thailand into affordable homes for early-career individuals, offering low-cost housing near public transport. Mortgage payments start at 4,000 Baht per month, with leaseholds capped at 99 years.

- ❖ Targeting working-age individuals with stable incomes who lack housing, eligible applicants will enter a lottery conducted by the Government Lottery Office after passing a screening by the Government Housing Bank.
- ❖ Since registration opened on January 17, 350,000 people have expressed interest, with 140,000 passing the initial screening.
- ❖ The Cabinet also has approved the Ministry of Energy's plan to reduce the electricity price from 4.15 Baht per unit to 3.99 Baht for the May-August billing period, without relying on additional subsidies.



- Thai energy companies who have invested in renewal energy in Vietnam are starting to feel the pain of the government renegading on its commitment of the power purchase agreement (PPA).
 - ❖ News reports in various international media outlets suggests that companies such as
 - B Grimm Power Plc
 - Gulf Energy Development Plc
 - Banpu Plc
 - Gunkul Engineering Plc
 - Super Energy Corporation Plc

Are in trouble as Energy Vietnam (EVN), the equivalent to Thailand's EGAT (Energy Generating Authority of Thailand) has decided to slash the feed in tariff of the PPA by 25-50%.

None of the Thai listed energy producers who have invested more than US\$ 2 billion have come out to say what impact the measures by the EVN is going to have on their investments in Vietnam.

- The Stock Exchange of Thailand (SET) index closed at 1,168.02 points yesterday, up 9.93 points (+0.86%), with a trading value of 26.39 billion Baht. The rise was driven by buying in energy stocks following an increase in oil prices.



- This came after the U.S. president signalled a possible import tax on goods from countries that import oil from Russia, pushing Brent crude prices higher. There was also a rebound in large-cap stocks, including banking and telecommunications, which had faced panic selling the previous day. However, trading volume in the Thai stock market remained low.

- Tassapon Bijleveld, CEO of Thai AirAsia X, announced that the airline plans to raise an additional 1 billion Baht from new investors. This funding will help Thai AirAsia X exit its business rehabilitation plan by 2025.
 - ❖ The company also plans to present its financial results for the first two quarters of this year to attract investors.
- Thonburi Healthcare Group Plc (THG) announced that its board of directors has approved a proposal for an extraordinary general meeting of shareholders to approve a registered capital reduction of 84.74 million Baht, bringing it down to 847.46 million Baht.
 - ❖ This will be followed by a capital increase of 941.68 million Baht, raising the total to 1,789.15 million Baht through the issuance of 941.68 million new shares with a par value of 1.00 Baht per share.
 - ❖ The newly issued shares will be allocated through a private placement (PP) to Ramkhamhaeng Hospital Plc (RAM), the major shareholder, and to other existing shareholders. As a result, RAM's stake in THG will increase but will not exceed 49.99%.
 - ❖ THG expects to raise a total of 6.28 billion Baht from the PP to RAM and the share offering to existing shareholders. The funds will be used to repay loans by 2025.



- Yesterday, gold prices fluctuated 18 times before closing 550 Baht higher than the previous day.
 - ❖ The buying price for gold jewelry was 49,588.36 Baht per Baht-weight, while the selling price was 51,400.00 Baht. For gold bars, the buying price was 50,500.00

Baht per Baht-weight, and the selling price was 50,600.00 Baht. The gold spot price stood at \$3,132.50 per ounce.

Political News

- Yesterday evening, the House of Representatives website added a special agenda for the upcoming session on April 3.
 - ❖ Normally, this session would address live questions, various motions, and reports from committees that have completed their reviews. However, this meeting will also consider five draft bills proposed by the Cabinet, including the Entertainment Complex Bill, which is now set for review by the House. This is a change from the previously stated date of April 9.
 - ❖ Meanwhile, on Wednesday, April 2, a group of academics and students will submit a petition to oppose the consideration of the Entertainment Complex Bill to the Speaker of the House at 10:00 AM at Parliament.



- The main opposition People's Party said the government should prioritize deliberation on the earthquake instead of the bill to legalize casinos inside entertainment complexes.



- ❖ Opposition leader Natthaphong Ruengpanyawut questioned the government's urgency to pass the bill before the session concludes, given that the feasibility study for the entertainment complexes is still unfinished.
- ❖ The main opposition party has set up six teams to investigate various issues, including the collapsed State Audit Office building, assist earthquake victims seeking compensation, monitor the government's cell broadcast system (set to launch by July), and develop a long-term disaster response plan.
- The Metropolitan Police Bureau has extended the 50-meter no-protest zone around Government House until April 6. This extension comes as the police aim to manage protests from the People's Movement for a Just Society (P-Move), which is calling for changes to conservation laws and an end to the impact of the royal decree on conservation projects in national parks, wildlife sanctuaries, and hunting grounds.
 - ❖ It also addresses protests from anti-Thaksin and royalist groups against the legalization of casinos in entertainment complexes and online gambling.
 - ❖ In response to P-Move's demands, the government has agreed in principle to review and amend the National Parks Act and the Wildlife Conservation Act. Other agreements include:
 - Halting actions that may harm communities' livelihoods in conservation areas.
 - Delaying the declaration of 23 new conservation forest areas.
 - Urgently surveying land ownership to resolve disputes.
 - Appointing representatives to the Office of Community Land Title's coordinating committee.

- Pushing for a draft amnesty for affected citizens.



- On April 3, Prime Minister Paetongtarn Shinawatra will preside over the opening of a government administration workshop at Alvarez Hotel in Buriram.
 - ❖ The event will be attended by Deputy Prime Minister and Interior Minister Anutin Charnvirakul, senior officials from the Interior Ministry, provincial governors from across the country, and representatives from Provincial Administrative Organizations (PAO).
 - ❖ Observers are watching closely to see if Buriram United Football Club executive chairman Newin Chidchob, a key figure in the stronghold of the Bhumjaithai Party, will personally welcome the prime minister during her visit.



- Yesterday, at his home in Muang Thong Thani, Sanoh Thienthong, Chairman of the Advisory Board of the Pheu Thai Party, hosted a gathering for politicians, government officials, businesspeople, and close associates to celebrate his 92nd birthday.
 - ❖ Notable attendees included former Prime Minister Thaksin Shinawatra, Dr. Cholnan Srikaew, an MP from Nan province, and Surachart Thienthong. The atmosphere was warm and friendly.

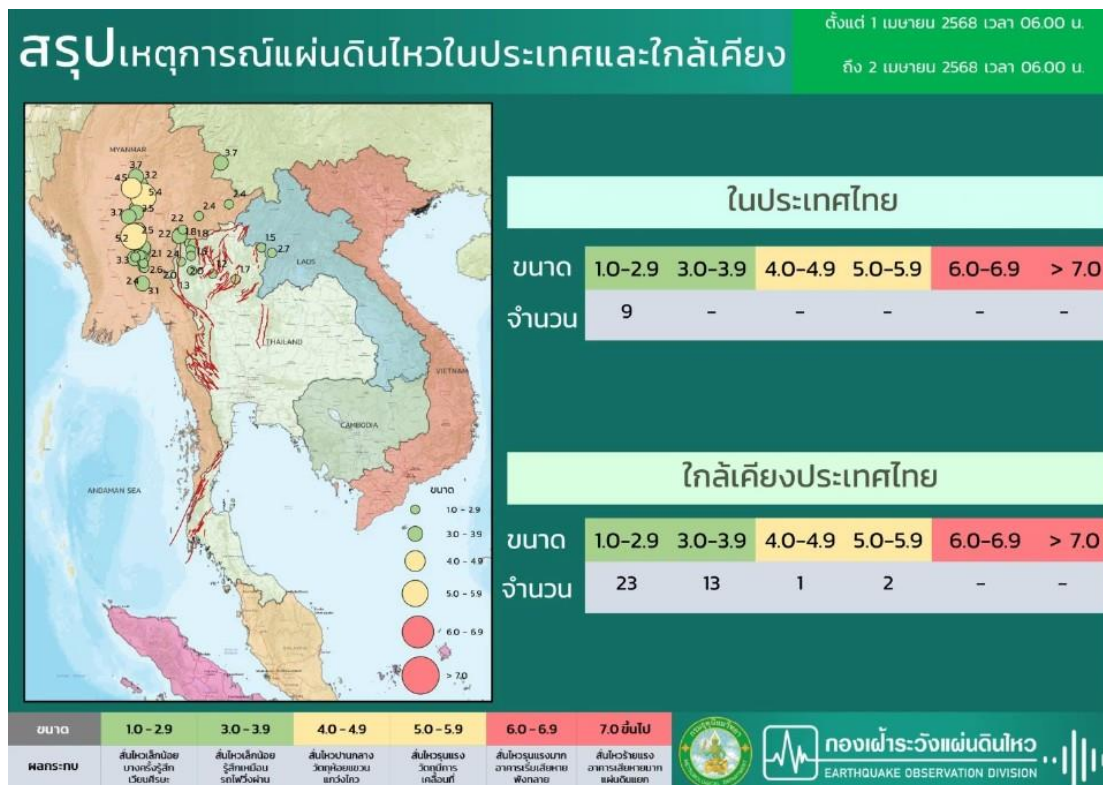
